




<b>Potentially Hazardous Products</b>	<b>Safer Alternatives</b>
Aerosol spray	 Pump spray bottle
Air freshener	 Simmer cinnamon and cloves
Antifreeze marked with WARNING	 Antifreeze with no C-W-D-P*
Aphid poison	 Spray with water three times weekly. Or squirt with soapy water.
Chlorine bleach to whiten clothes	 Non-chlorine bleach
Dishwashing soap marked with CAUTION	 Dishwashing soap with no C-W-D-P*
Drain opener with lye	 Pour a kettle of boiling water down the drain. Or use a plumber's snake.
Flea collar	 Flea comb
Oil based paint	 Latex or water-based paint
Oven cleaner with lye	 Bon Ami

<b>Potentially Hazardous Products</b>	<b>Safer Alternatives</b>
Rat or mouse poison	 Rat or mouse trap
Roach poison	 Roach trap
Rubber cement	 White glue or glue stick
Scouring powder	 Use baking soda and scrub
Shower cleaner with WARNING or CAUTION	 Shower cleaner with no C-W-D-P*
Slug poison	 Slug trap
Spot remover	 Blot with club soda
Toilet bowl cleaner with DANGER	 Bon Ami
Weed poison	 Weed puller
Yellow jacket poison	 Yellow jacket trap

\*C-W-D-P = Caution-Warning-Danger-Poison
