Volunteering to participate in the Flagstaff Regional Land Use and Transportation Plan update will be a thirty month process, beginning December 2008 and wrapping up with final document adoption in fall 2011. There are five opportunities to participate:

1. **Citizen Advisory Committee (CAC)** will meet monthly from December 2008 to April 2011; this committee is appointed by City Council and County Supervisors and guides the process; 15 members.
2. **Focus Groups** will meet quarterly during the process, and different groups will focus on different elements of the plan. Open membership, looking for experts in the field of focus. *See groups next page.*
3. **Town Hall Meetings** are quarterly public open houses to discuss the work thus far.
4. **Board & Commission Meetings** are always open to the public and will be part of the process
5. **Public Hearings** will be the formal process in adopting the updated plan, are open to the public and invite public comment.
