



Energy Rebate Program Requirements



The following requirements along with an energy audit from a Building Performance Institute certified contractor must be met in order to qualify for a rebate. Please submit all paperwork via e-mail to sustainability@flagstaffaz.gov, in person at 101 W Cherry Ave, or by mail to:

Air Sealing	Rebate for sealing air leaks in the building envelope. Home's existing leakage must be 16 ACH50 or higher. Blower-door tests must be used to determine the level of air-changes before and after air sealing measures are implemented.
Attic Insulation	Rebate for installation of insulation up to R-50 . Attic must have an initial insulation value of R-19 or lower. Insulation improvements must be made in combination with air sealing, unless documentation can prove that air sealing is unnecessary.
Crawl Space Insulation	Rebate for installation or re-alignment of insulation of R-19 will qualify for a rebate of up to \$100. Insulation of R-30 or greater will qualify for a rebate of up to \$200. Insulation must be secured to ensure continuous contact with subfloor.
Duct Sealing	Rebate for reduction of air leaks in duct system, as measured by a pre and post test measured in CFM25 or CFM50 . Acceptable methods of duct-leakage testing include: blower door subtraction method (CFM50), duct blaster (CFM25), pressure pans (CFM50).
Furnace	Rebate for installation of new furnace with a minimum Annual Fuel Utilization Efficiency (AFUE) rating of 95% or higher.
Water Heater	Rebate for installation of new water heater with a minimum Energy Factor (EF) of .62 or better.
