#### **I. PRELIMINARY GENERAL BUSINESS**

##### **1. Announcements**

**1. Bicycle and Pedestrian Strategies**

The Committee also discussed strategies to make sure that rumble strips do not become a detriment or hazard for bicyclists.

The strategies will be reviewed and discussed at the next BAC meeting.

**2. 2012 Bike to Work Week**

The Committee was provided with a schedule of events for 2012 Bike-to-Work Week.

**3. McConnell Drive Road Safety Assessment**

Mr. Ince summarized the preliminary findings of the Road Safety Assessment for McConnell Drive. The recommendations will include shoulders or bike lanes on both sides of the road from Beulah to Pine Knoll, including bike lanes between the through lane and right-turn lanes. Mr. Ince said he would provide a copy of the report to the BAC when it is available.

**III. OLD BUSINESS**

**1. ADOT Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan Update**

Mr. Ince provided a summary of the planning process.

The Committee indicated that the shoulder of I-40 from A-1 Road to Bellemont is falling apart and has become unrideable.

The Committee asked if Michael Sanders could be invited to an upcoming meeting to discuss the master plan.

**IV. CONCLUDING GENERAL BUSINESS**

**1. Reports**

Mr. Ince indicated that an ordinance addressing electric bikes was being prepared and would be reviewed at an upcoming BAC meeting.
