REQUESTED ACTION: Accept Phase II Cultural Resource Study

As a result of previous studies, two significant cultural resources have been identified- the buildings at 17 and 17 ½ S Mikes Pike Street. The Hub on Campus Flagstaff project would result in major impacts to these two buildings. Relocation of the buildings, in lieu of demolition, is recommended. Electronic copy attached.

Commissioner Edwards recused himself due to a conflict of interest. Commissioner Edwards vacated the meeting at 4:16. Lauren Clementino presented on topic and answered commissions questions regarding original materials located inside both buildings and the possibility of moving 17 S Mike's Pike. Staff inquired if the originals doors, hardware, kitchen cabinets, etc, would be available for donation if 17½ S Mike's Pike were to be demolished. Applicant stated they would donate the items or make them available for restoration for other projects. Chair Zimmerman stated the top portion of the SHPO Inventory Form was not completed. Ms. Clementino said the PDF was editable and will ensure all portions are filled out and resubmit to HPO. Commissioner Corbin motioned to accept the CRS (phase II) for 17 and 17½ S Mike's Pike on the condition the SHPO Inventory Form is completed and resubmitted. Commissioner Dunn seconded; the motion passed by unanimous consent with one recusal. Commissioner Edwards returned at 4:26 pm.

REQUESTED ACTION: Accept Historic Facades and Signs Grant application

Applicant is rehabilitating the property located at 23 S Agassiz St and is applying for a Historic Facades and Signs Grant with the intention of rehabilitating as many of the original materials as possible and/or placing new materials on top of original for preservation. The scope of work includes repointing the mortar in the chimney, replacing broken glass, reconstructing wood frame windows, rehabilitation of the siding, reinforcing the original roof structure, and installing 3-D cedar-look shingles.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Accept Historic Facades and Signs Grant application

Commissioner Edwards recused himself due to a conflict of interest. Commissioner Edwards vacated the meeting at 4:31. Prior to Mr. Coaloa presenting, HPO explained to commission that this project will involve more reviews as it moves along, but this grant application will get the project started. Mr. Coaloa presented on topic and answered commission's questions regarding specifics for the grant. Commission asked if painting was allowed to be part of the grant, due to denying previous applicants painting requests and paint is more a maintenance issue rather than preservation. HPO stated the grant budget could be revised with the painting quotes excluded, but still meet all the qualifications for the grant. Commission agreed and discussion ensued concerning foundational issues, rehabilitation of the siding, materials for the roof, and repointing the mortar in the chimney.

Public Comment:

Cody Canning of 20 S Agassiz stated his support for Mr. Coaloa and would encourage the commission to do anything and everything it can to help this project.

Bill Newland of 19 S Agassiz also stated his support for Mr. Coaloa and is excited about the project.

Commissioner Corbin motioned to approve the Historic Facades and Signs Grant on the condition that a revised budget excluding the paint portion is submitted to the HPO and the HPO gives his consent.

Commissioner Dunn seconded the motion; the motion passed unanimously with one recusal. Commissioner Edwards returned at 4:48 pm.
