II. NEW BUSINESS

1. Interstate 40 – Initial Design Concept Report

The Arizona Department of Transportation is in the process of preparing a Design Concept Report (DCR) for the I-40 corridor through Flagstaff, from Bellemont to Winona. The DCR presents concepts and alternatives for interchanges and crossings (including FUTS crossings). A short presentation on the DCR will be provided, and the BAC will have an opportunity to discuss and provide comments on bicycle accommodation at several of the interchanges and crossings in Flagstaff.

2. ADOT Bicycle Safety Action Plan

The Arizona Department of Transportation is in the process of preparing a Bicycle Safety Action Plan for all state highways in Arizona. Twenty-one segments of ADOT highways statewide are identified in the plan as priority locations for vehicle-bicycle crashes; of these 4 are located in Flagstaff. For this agenda item the BAC is asked to review the draft plan and discuss comments to forward to ADOT.

3. Reprint of Flagstaff Urban Trails and Bikeways Map

The current version of the map was printed in May 2009, and almost all of the 30,000 copies have been given out. The City is planning to reprint the Flagstaff Urban Trails and Bikeways Map later this winter or in early spring. The intent of this agenda item is to discuss and review any needed revisions to the map in advance of the reprint.
