II. NEW BUSINESS

A. City of Flagstaff – Bicycle Advisory and Pedestrian Advisory Committee Appointments

The Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committees both have appointments to fill vacant positions.

Staff Recommendation: Action item, review staff report and appoint members.

B. City of Flagstaff – Flagstaff Pulliam Airport – Paid Parking Program

Airport Director Barney Helmick will be presenting some new information regarding the Paid Parking program at the Flagstaff Pulliam Airport.

Staff Recommendation: Project update, no formal action requested.

C. Linda Vista Speeding Concerns

A resident along the 1300 block of Linda Vista contacted the City with concerns of speeding along Linda Vista Drive. This is near the East end of Linda Vista approximately at the intersection of Linda Vista and Chinwood.

Linda Vista Drive is a Minor Collector roadway in East Flagstaff traversing through several residential neighborhoods – Upper Greenlaw, Swiss Manor, Shadow Mountain to name a few.

The City collected speed and volume data this Fall and has processed and reviewed the numbers.

Additionally, we have run the data through the Residential Traffic Management program tool and found that speeds and volumes both score above the Transportation Commissions suggested thresholds.

Staff Recommendation: Review the presentation materials, receive public feedback and provide direction on a path forward for this potential project.

D. Fremont Avenue Speeding Concerns

The City has received multiple calls regarding speeding along Fremont Avenue in Cheshire.

Fremont Avenue is a Minor Collector Roadway that serves as the main collector roadway for the Cheshire and Linwood neighborhoods collecting residential traffic from more than a dozen local streets conveying those trips to the traffic signal-controlled intersection at Ft Valley Road (US HWY 180).

The first request came in for the 3000 block of Fremont which is near Cheshire Park and that's where speed and volume data has been collected. This section of Fremont has sidewalks on both sides and is striped with two bike lanes and four vehicular lanes, a parking lane along the Park and in some areas has a frontage road.

Since that initial request a second request came in for speeding concerns in the 2500 block which is near the Cheshire to Linwood neighborhood boundary. This section of Fremont has sidewalks and parkways on both

sides of the street and is striped with two parking lanes, two bike lanes and two vehicular lanes.

Speed and volume data has been collected for the first request, the second request came in when conditions were not conducive to counting. This location has been added to our growing list of Spring count locations.

Staff Recommendation: Review the presentation materials, receive public feedback and provide direction on a path forward for this potential project.
