ENERGY AND PLASTIC BAG USAGE IN GROCERY STORES

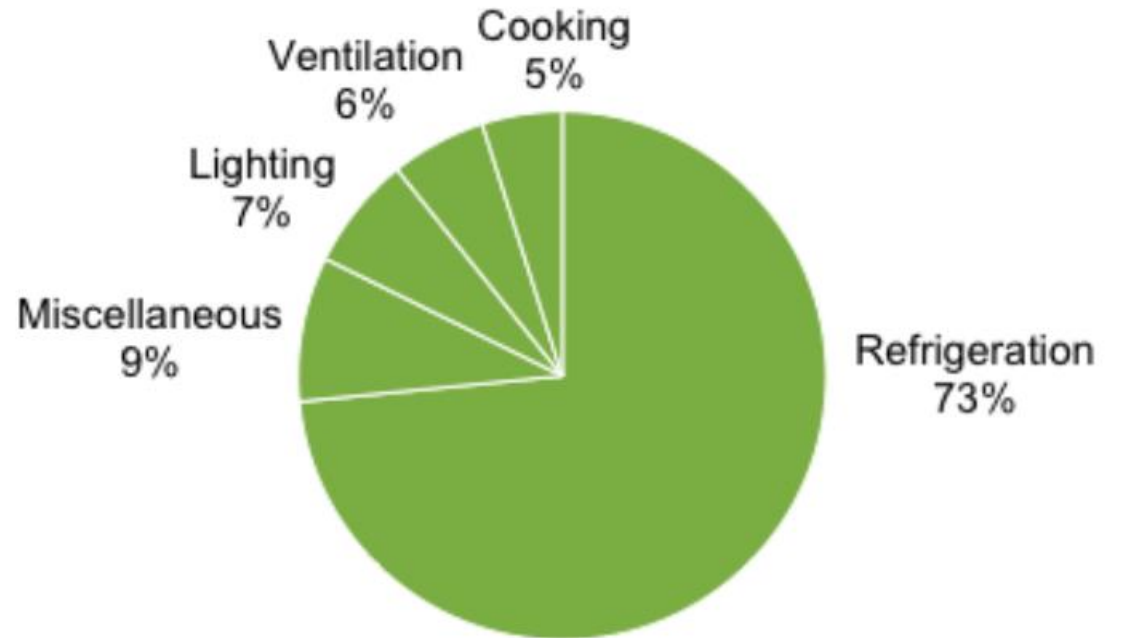
- Purpose: encourage grocery stores to limit energy and plastic bag usage

OUR PROCESS

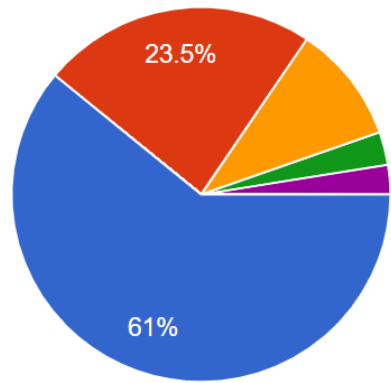
- Created and distributed poll

Electricity end uses in grocery stores



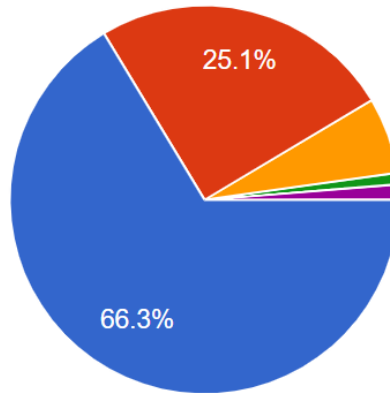
PROJECT STATUS: 315 POLL RESPONSES, 5 LETTERS!

- No plastic bags

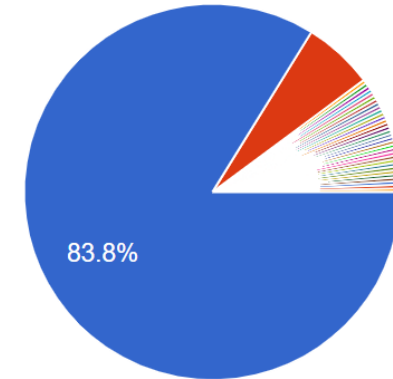


- Energy reduction
