## Top 2 Survey Picks



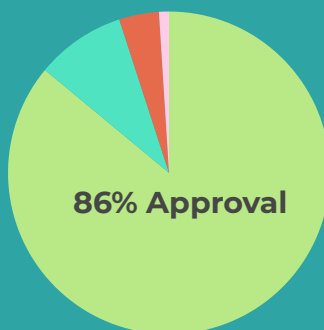
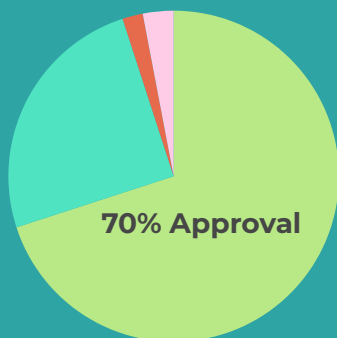
Overall, residents feel Recycled Water is a good option for Flagstaff

### Option 1:

Recycled water released into drainages for natural filtration aquifer recharge (what we are currently doing)

### Option 2:

Injecting Advanced Treated Recycled Water (potable quality) into the ground for aquifer recharge



## Ranked Priority Options:

1 Release Class A+ Recycled Water into natural drainages

2 Inject Advanced Treated Recycled Water (potable quality) into the ground

3 Add Class A+ Recycled Water to Upper Lake Mary

## Participants' Concerns:

\*Environmental contamination

\*Risks to human health

\*Capital costs

\*Infrastructure development

\*Energy intensity

\*Reduced natural filtration

\*Damage to the aquifer or riparian habitats

\*Taste of drinking water



## Next Step

Seepage study to evaluate ways to manage excess recycled water and recharge the aquifer
