Reliability and resiliency remain priorities for Flagstaff Water Services

It's good to know during these trying times, water quality and supply concerns are not an issue in Flagstaff. We have been consistently building resiliency and redundancy into our system for years, providing clean and safe water for our mountain town.

Water reliability is the foundation of Flagstaff's economy and quality of life. Unlike many other Arizona cities, Flagstaff does not import water from outside sources. We produce our own water locally from numerous wellfields, Lake Mary and the Inner Basin of the San Francisco Peaks. In 2019, we produced an average of 7.3 million gallons (MGD) of clean, high-quality potable water every day! Water from deep-well aquifers is high-quality and requires little treatment. Last year, Lake Mary provided 32% of the total city demand. It's a great economical and renewable resource that capitalizes on seasonal moisture. This water-inventory allows us to produce the most cost-effective supply, while delivering clean, good-tasting water to your tap. No bottle needed!

Our commitment is to provide safe and reliable water service, despite any emergency.
