

Ground-Breaking Infrastructure Upgrades Continue This Summer

Waterline Replacement Supports Service Reliability

Summertime brings opportunities for streets projects in Flagstaff. Phase I of the Coconino Estates Project broke ground this month, replacing water and sewer lines, adding fire hydrants, storm drains, curbs, gutters, new lighting, and then finally repaving the streets. It's a big improvement to safety and quality of life for Coconino Estates residents. This project will be completed in phases through 2022.

The Industrial Drive Waterline Project which begins August 3, installs over 2000 linear feet of 16" pipe between Steves Boulevard and Caden Court. Project completion date is
