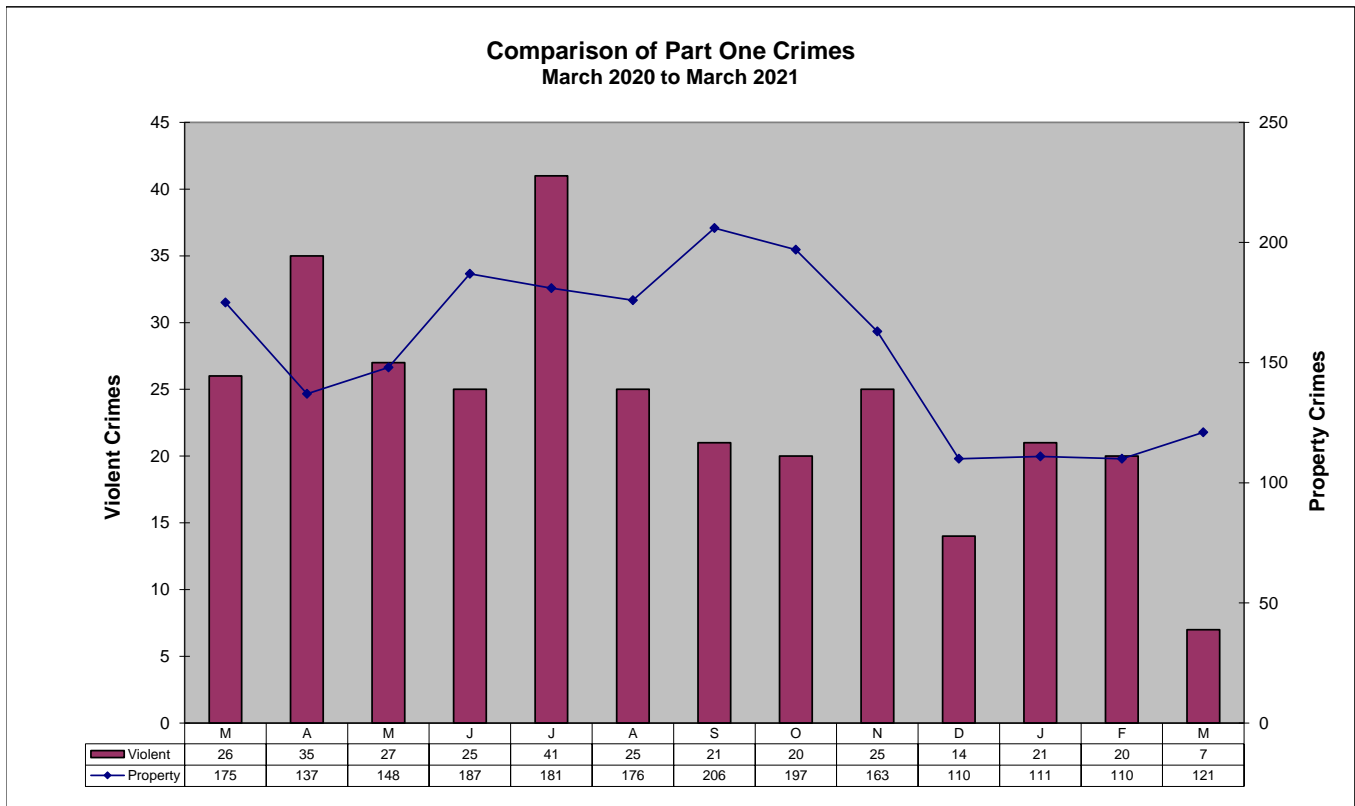

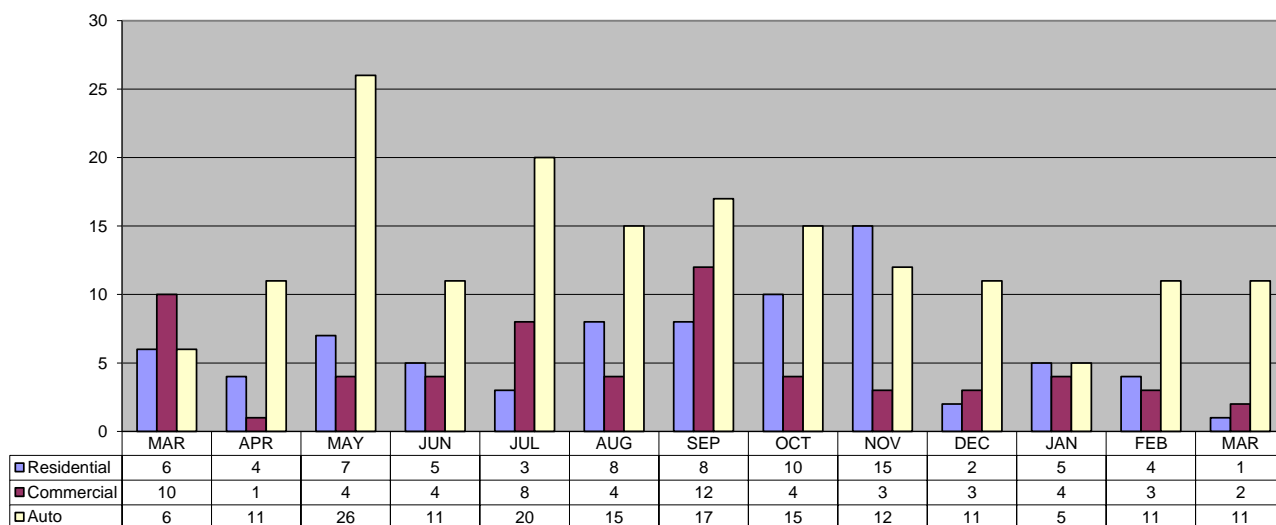

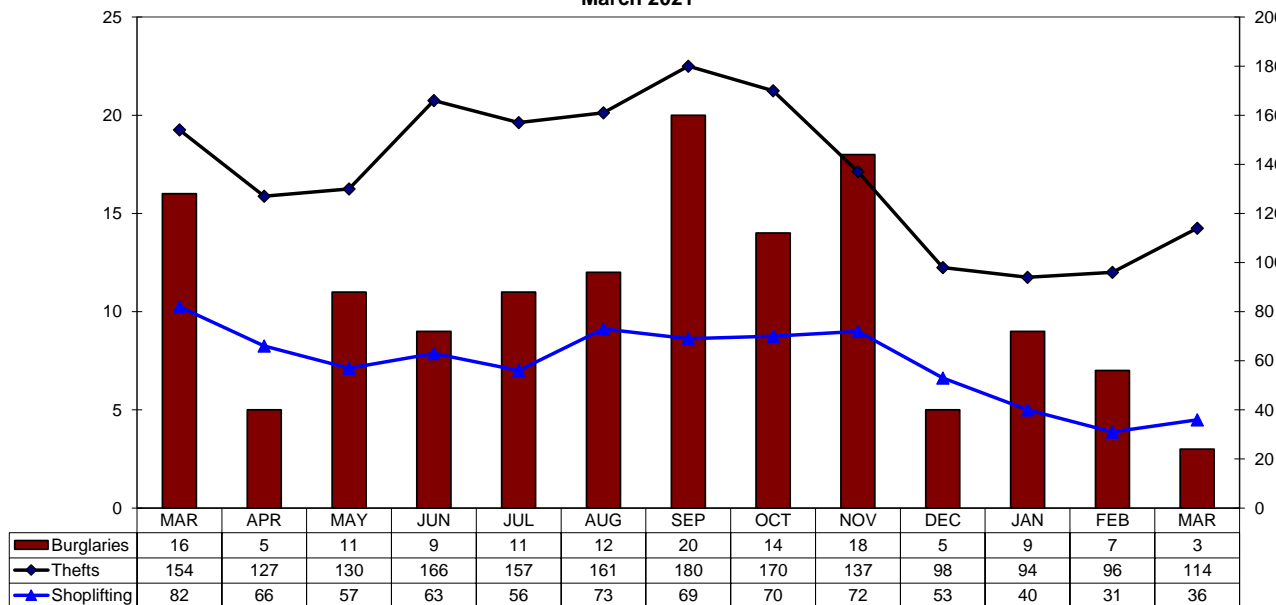

March 2020 to March 2021



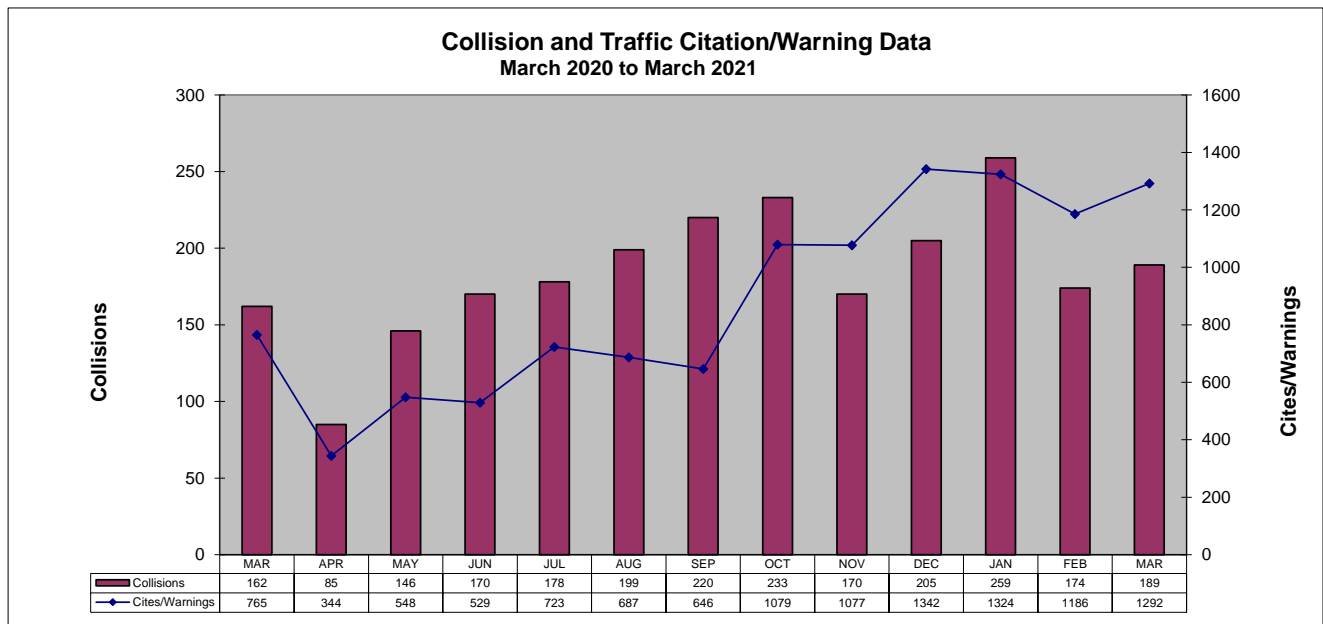
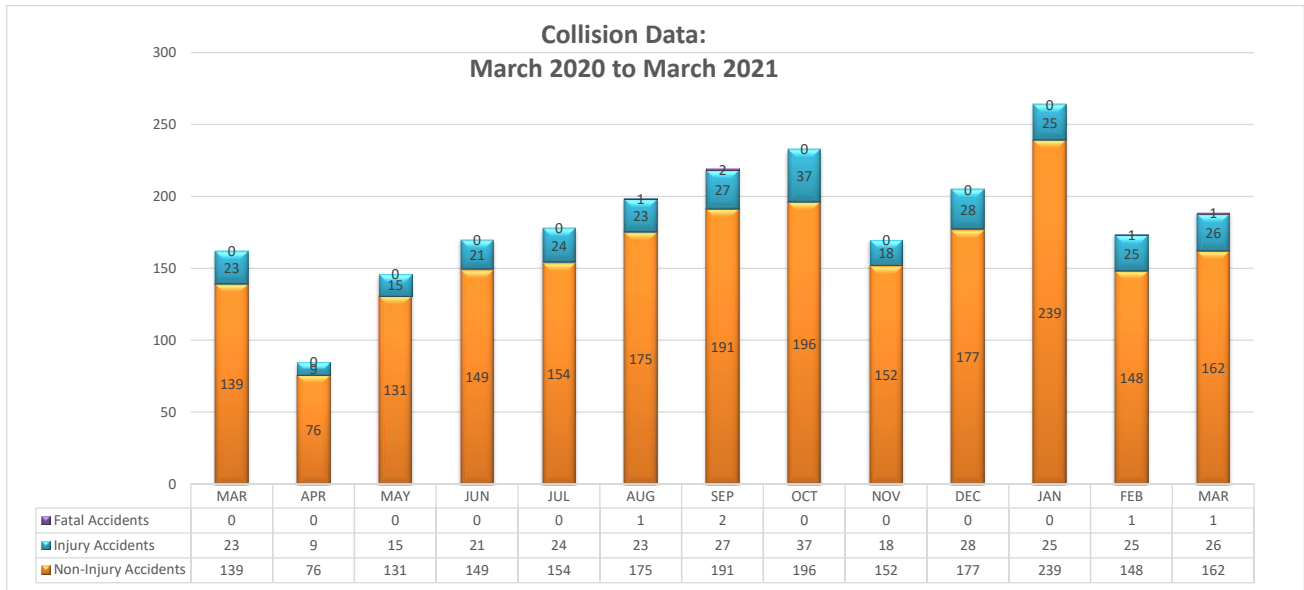
Thirteen Month Comparison of Thefts and Burglaries
March 2021



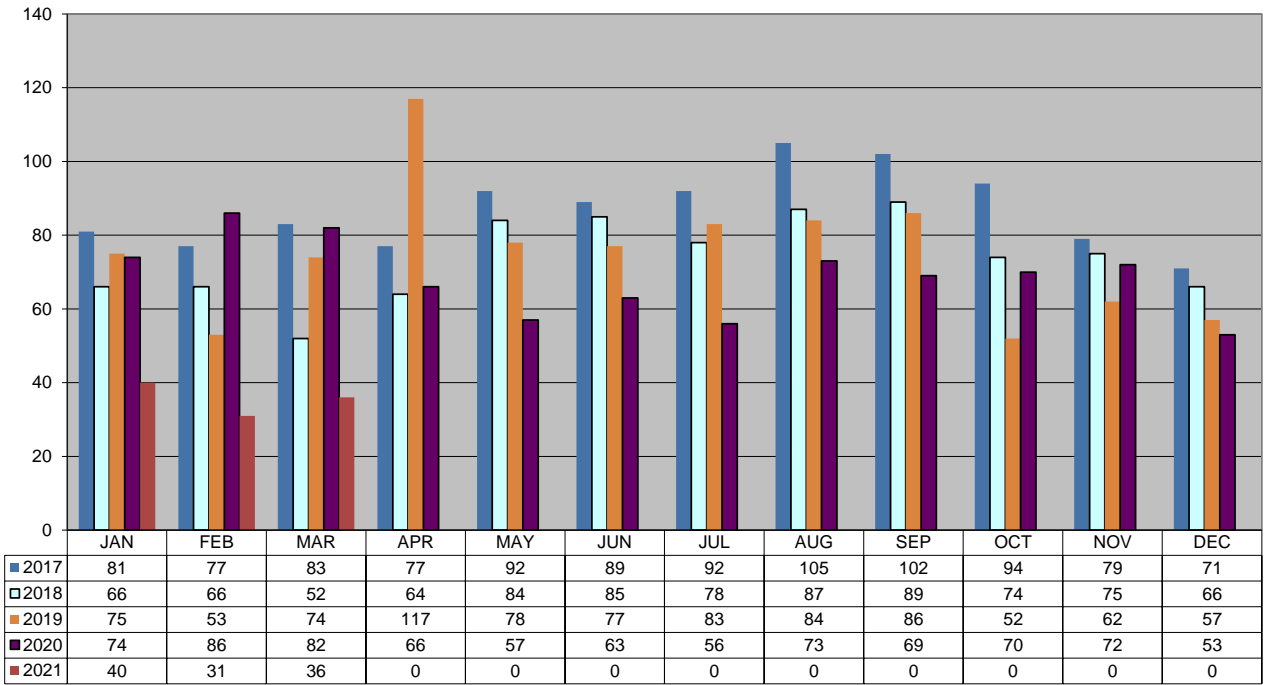

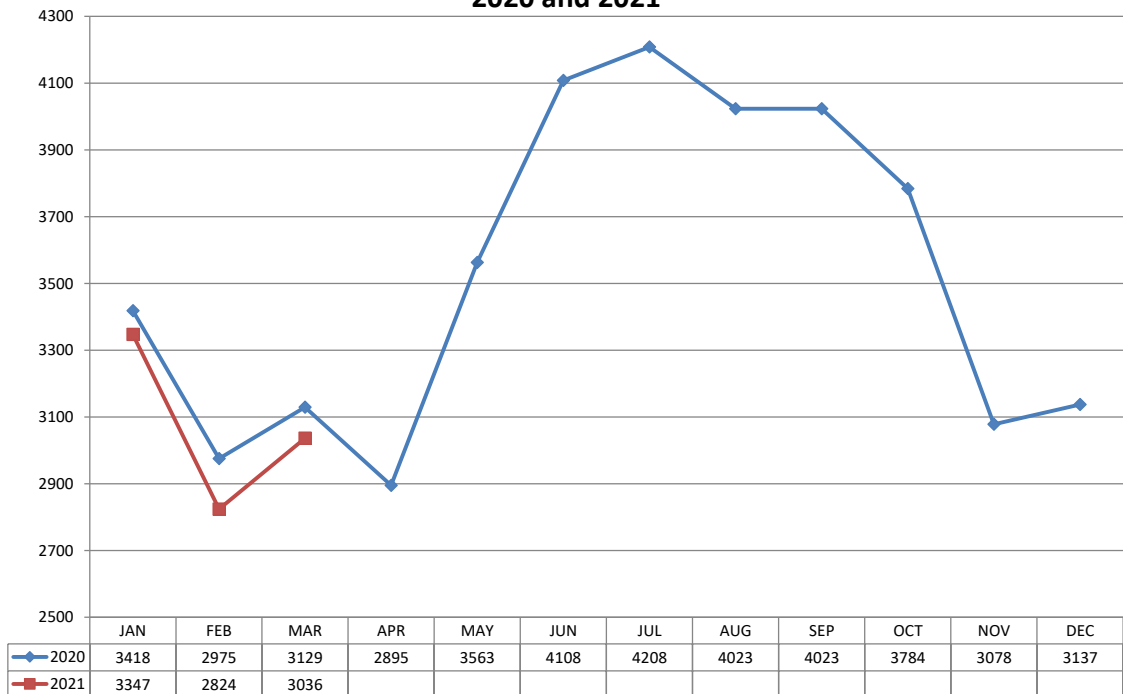

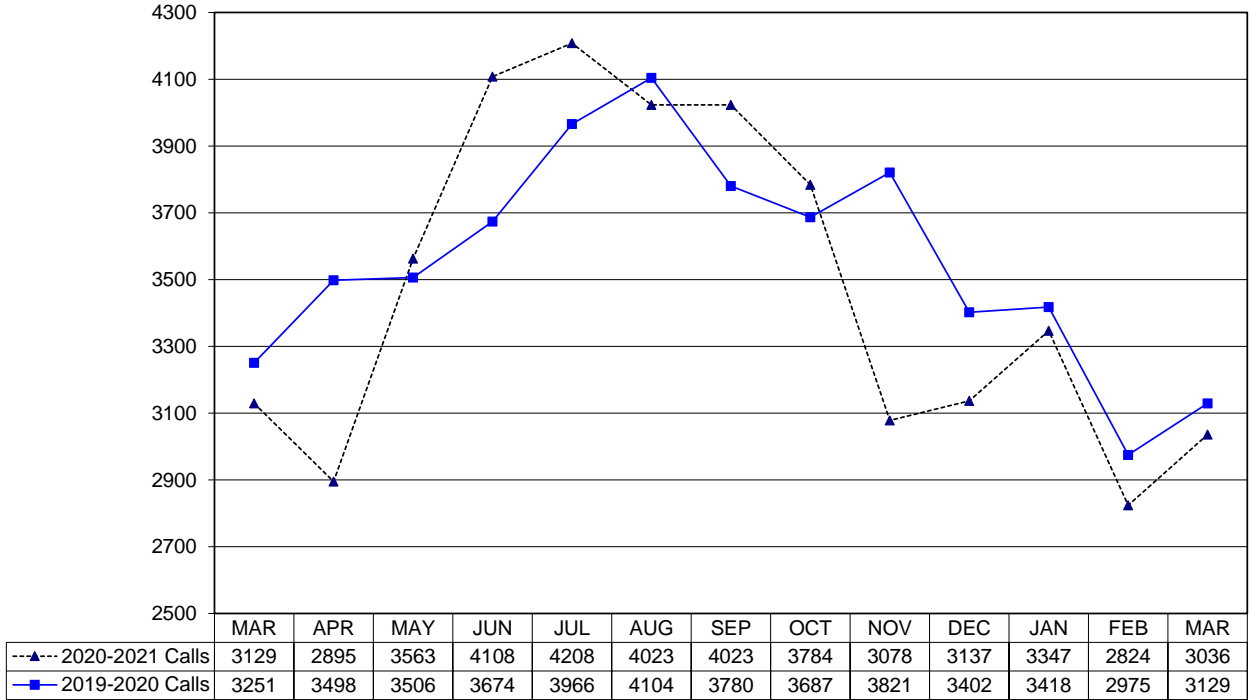
Shoplifting 5-Year Comparison



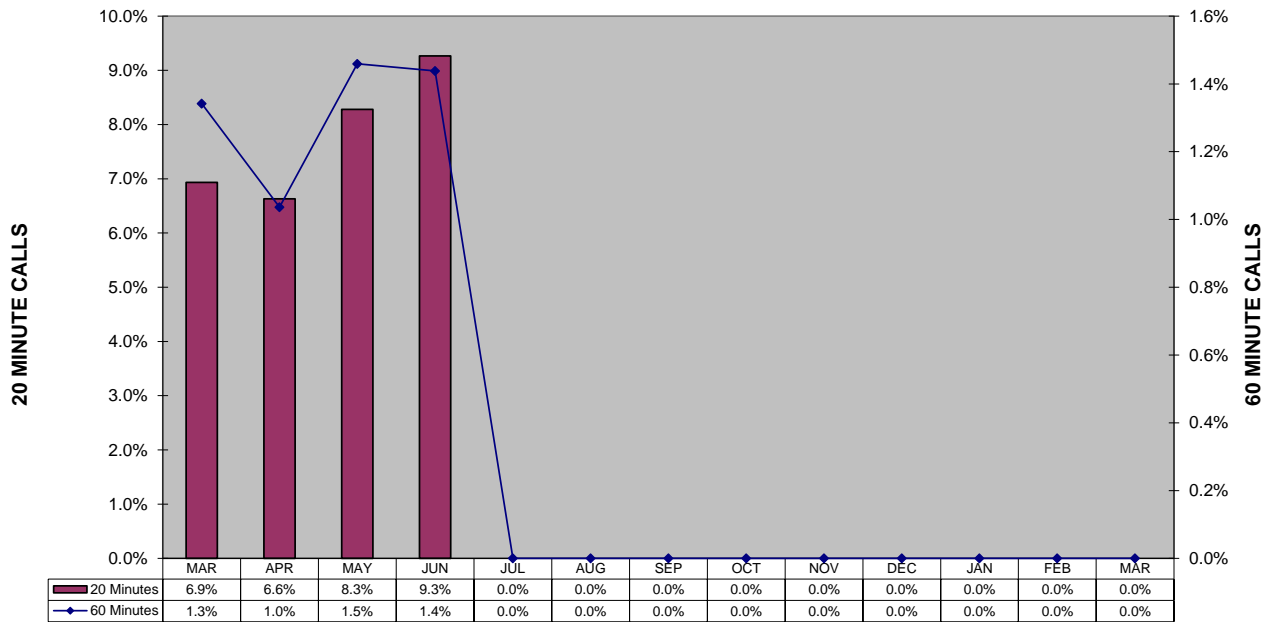
Police Calls for Service - 12 Month Trend 2020 and 2021



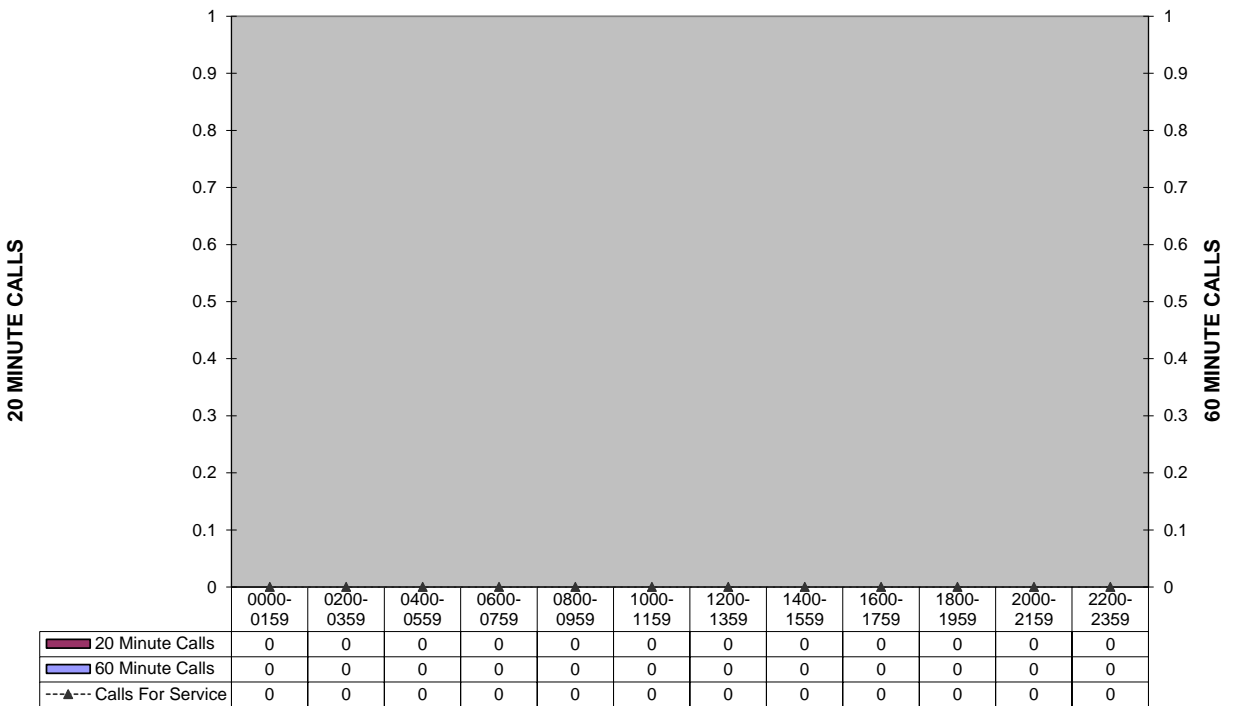
**Police Calls for Service - 13 Month Trend
March 2021**



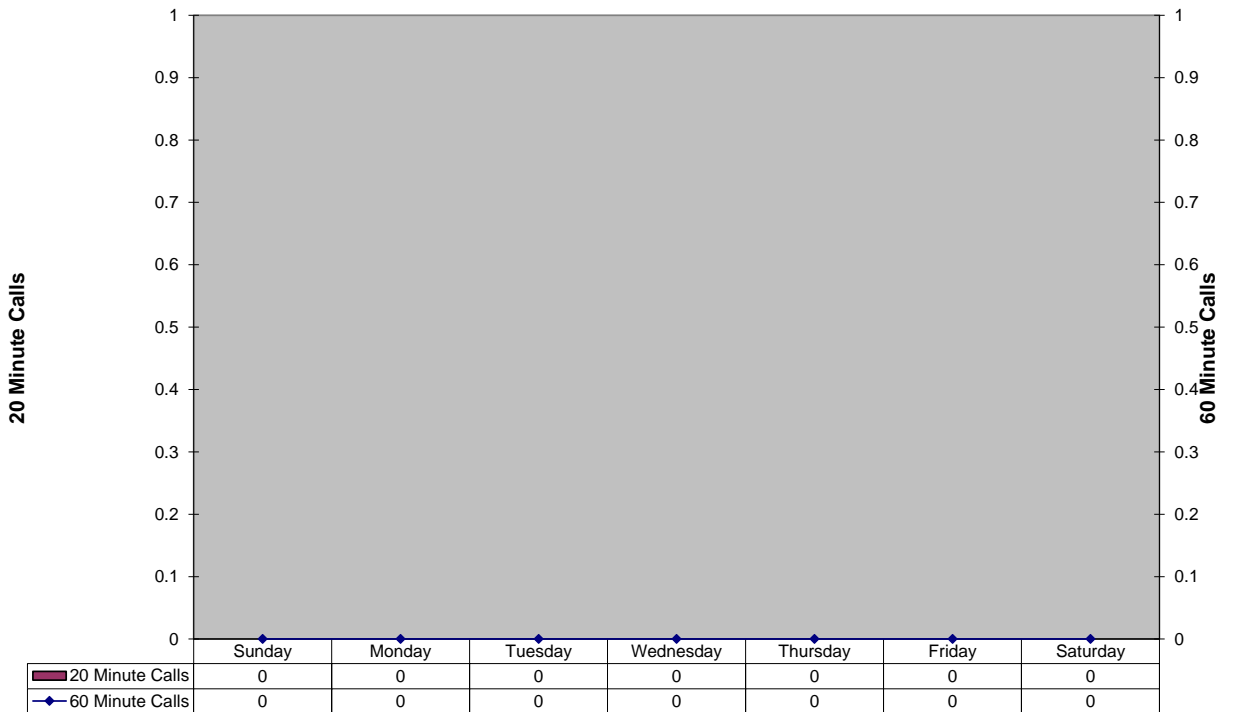
**Percent of Police Calls Held 20 and 60 Minutes

20 and 60 Minute Calls Held by Time of Day (This custom report is being configured)

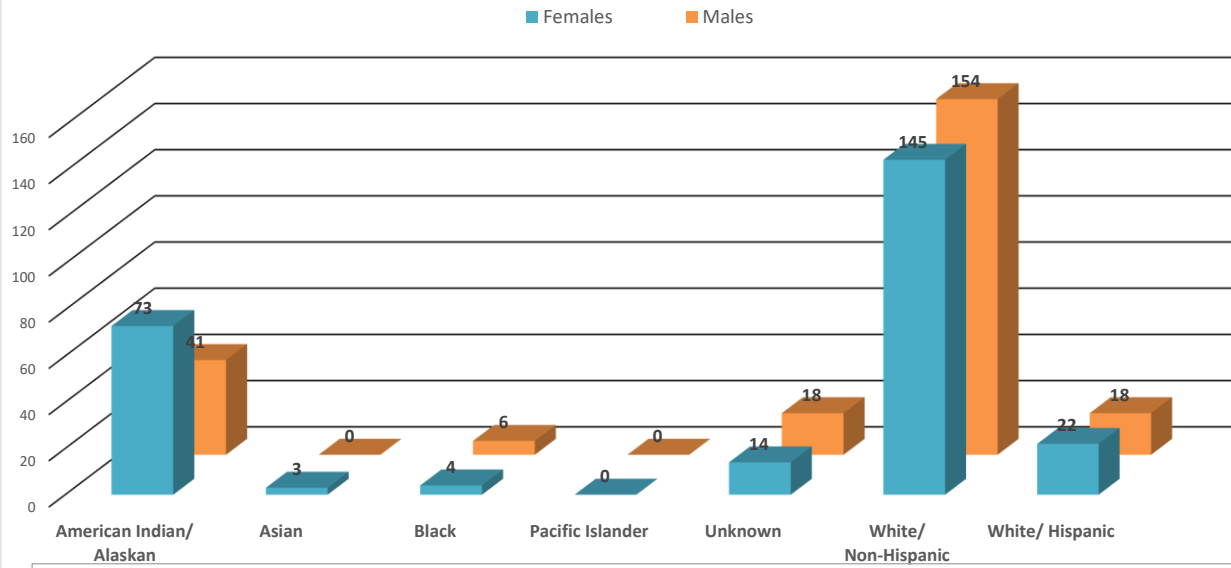


20 and 60 Minute Calls Holding by Day of Week (This custom report is being configured)

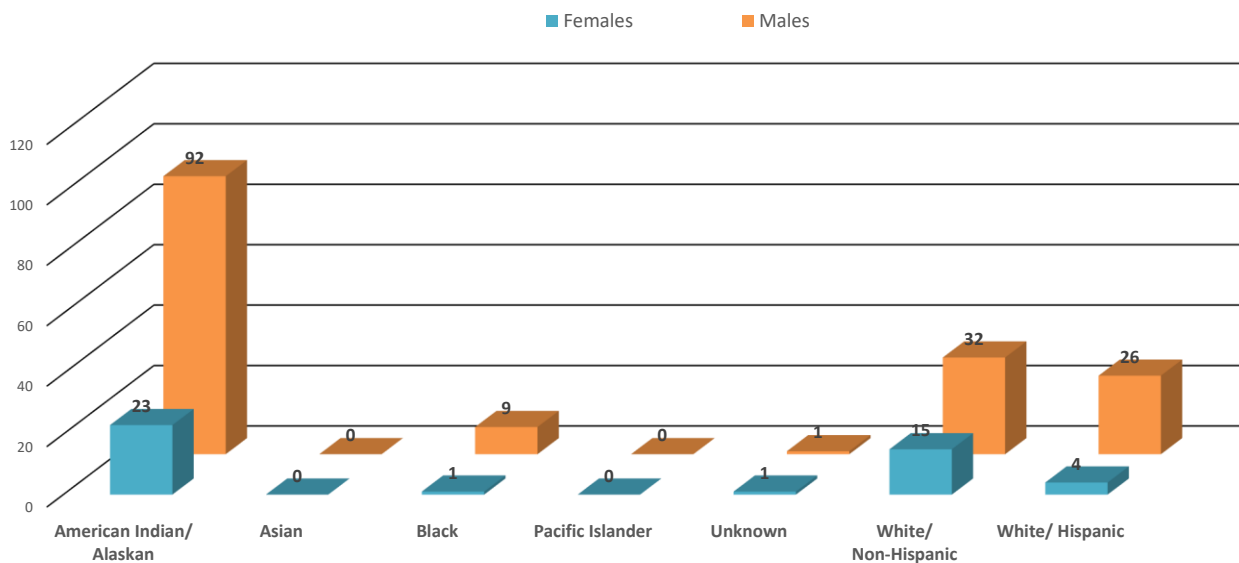

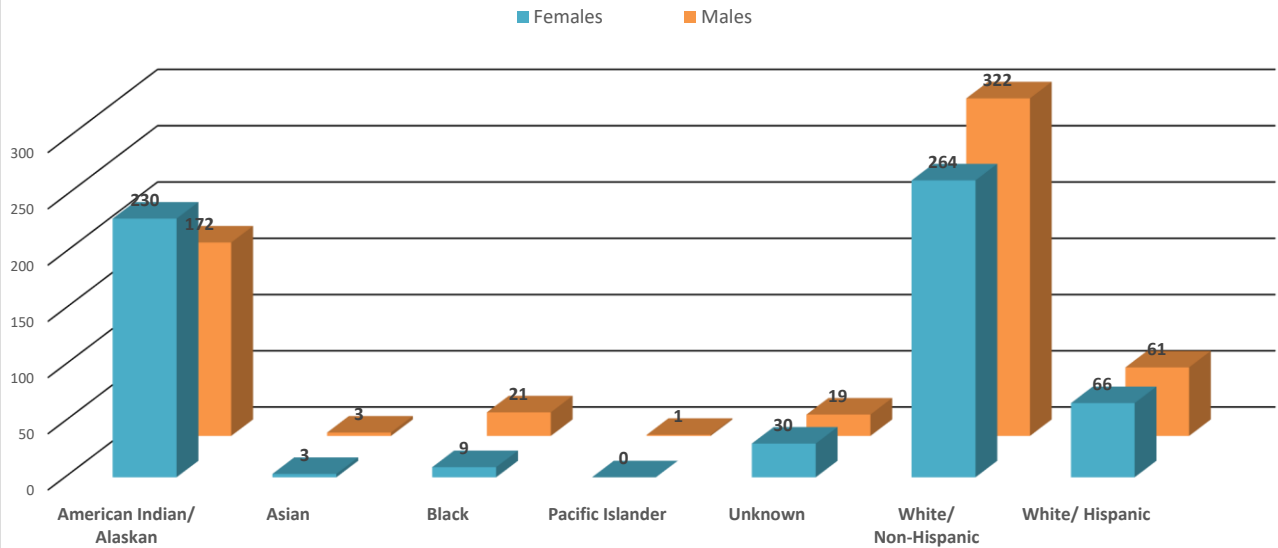

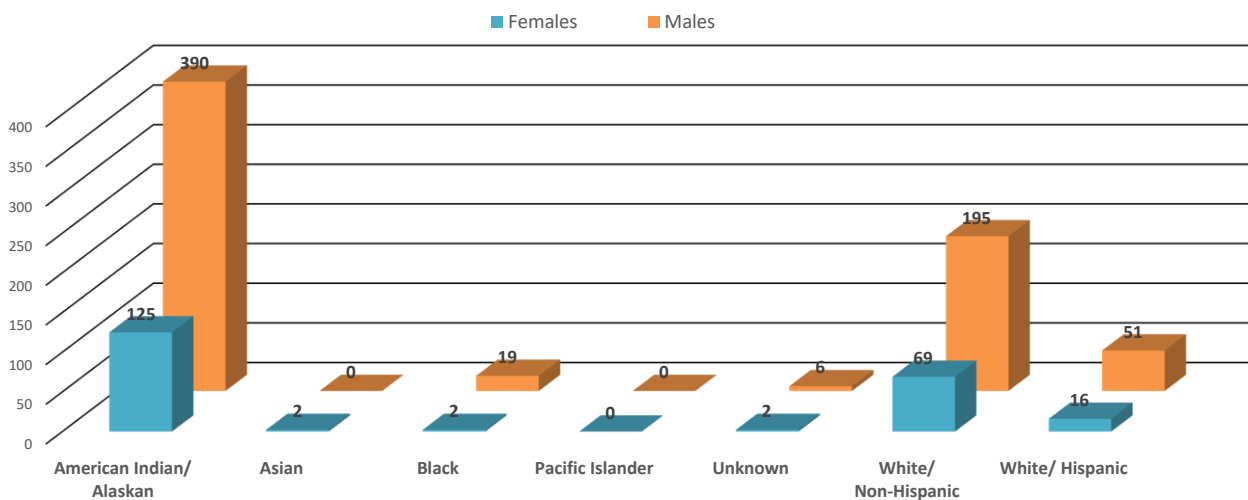
