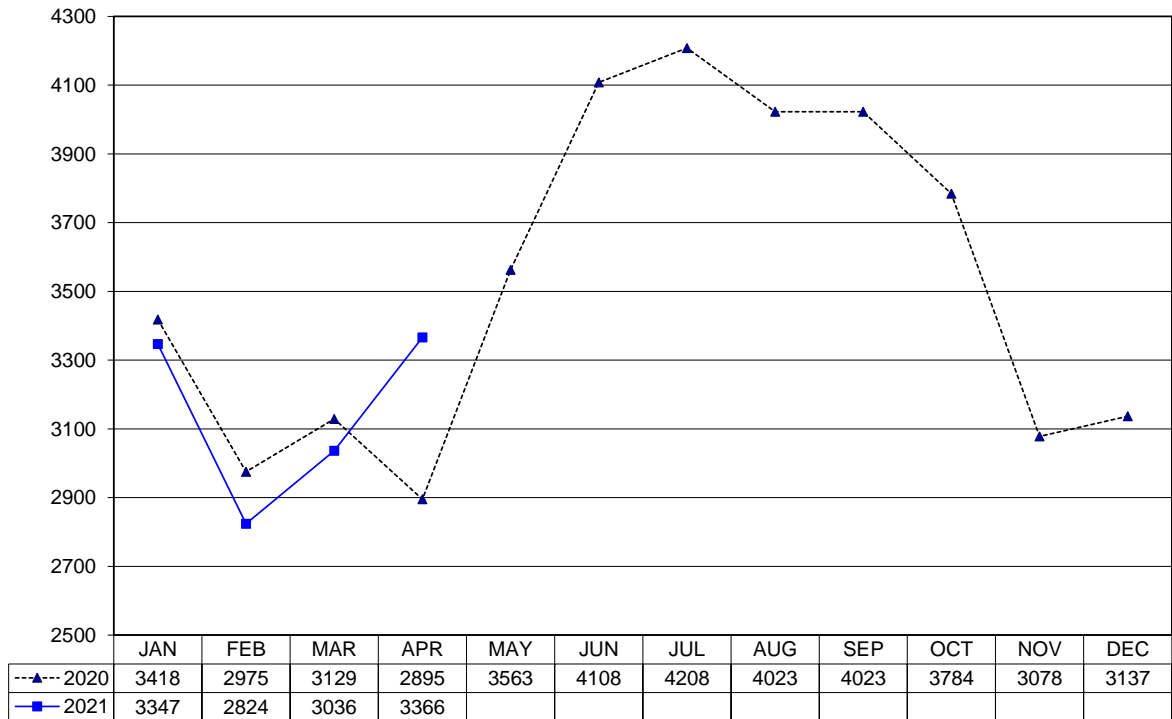

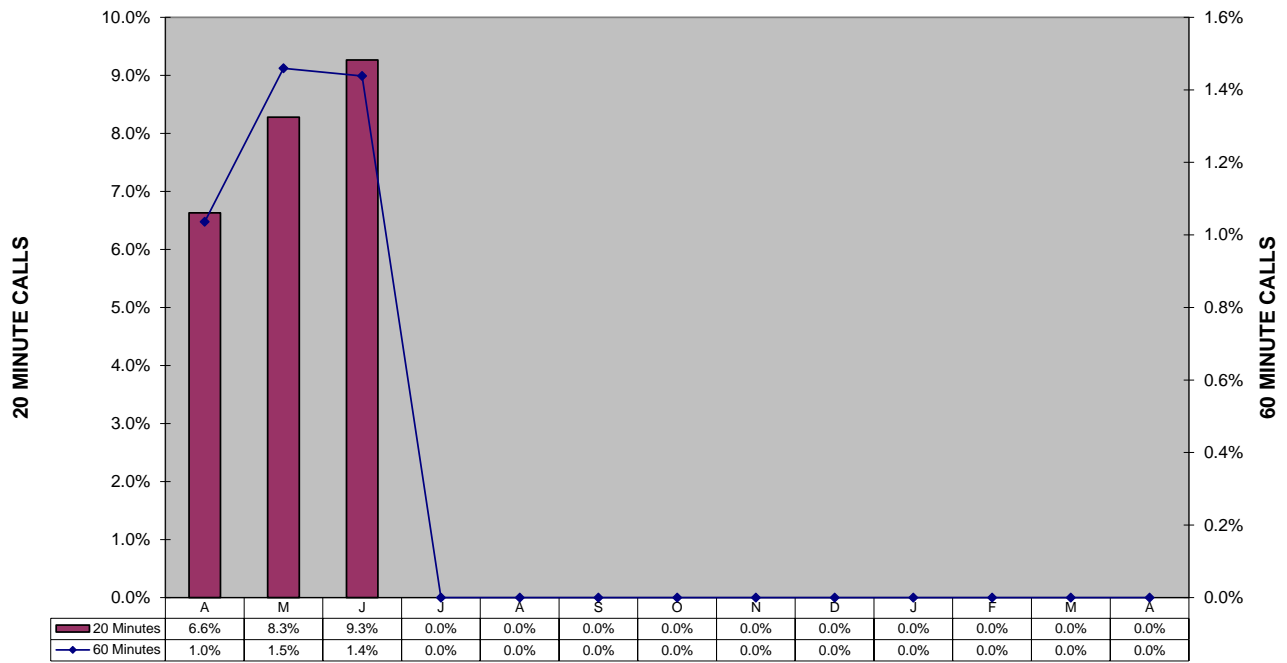
Shoplifting 5-Year Comparison



Police Calls for Service - 12 Month Trend April 2021

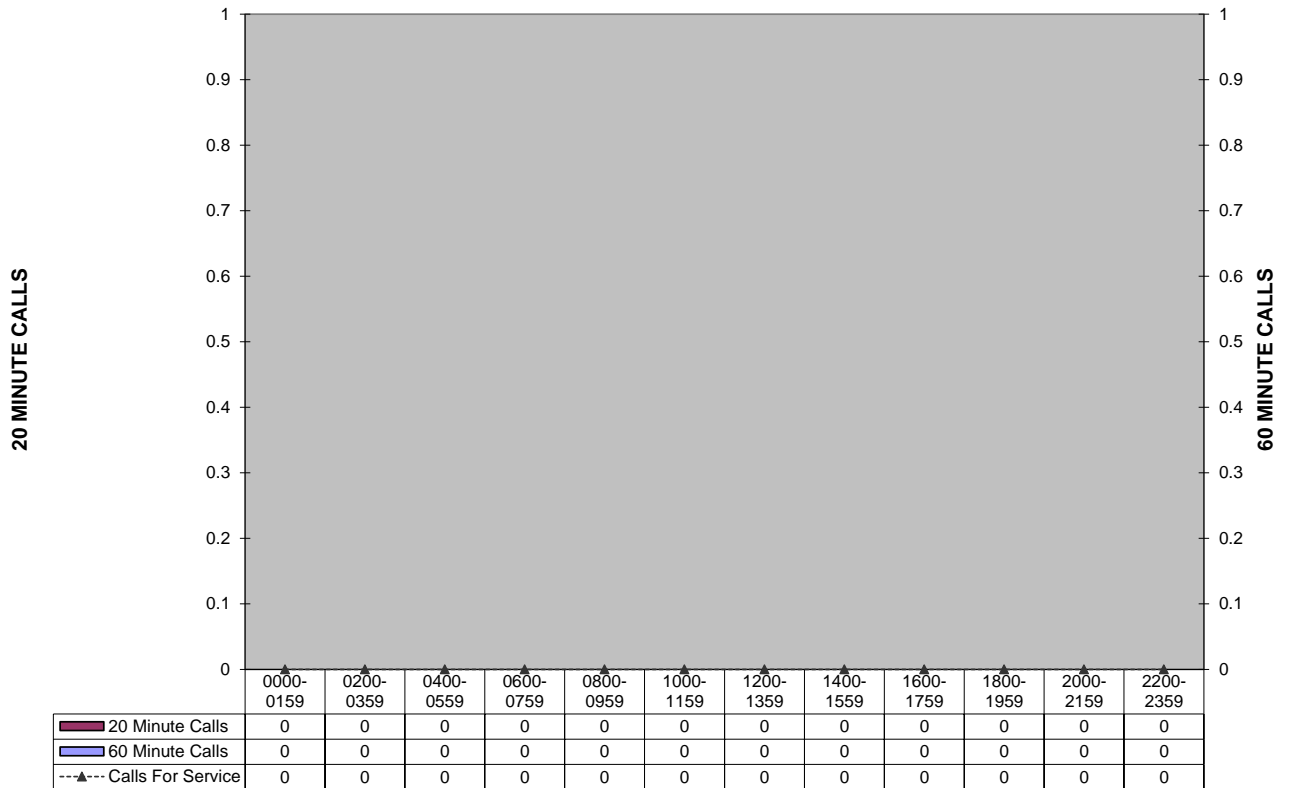


**Percent of Police Calls Held 20 and 60 Minutes
April 2020 to April 2021**

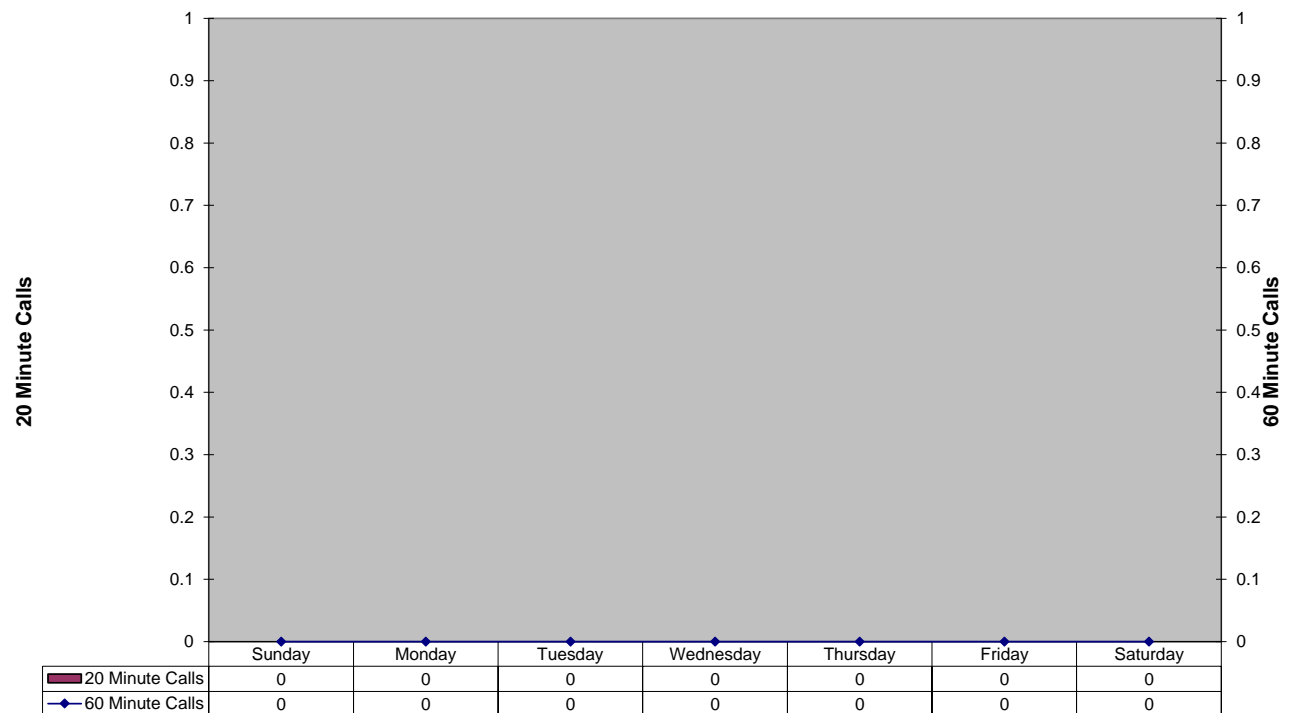

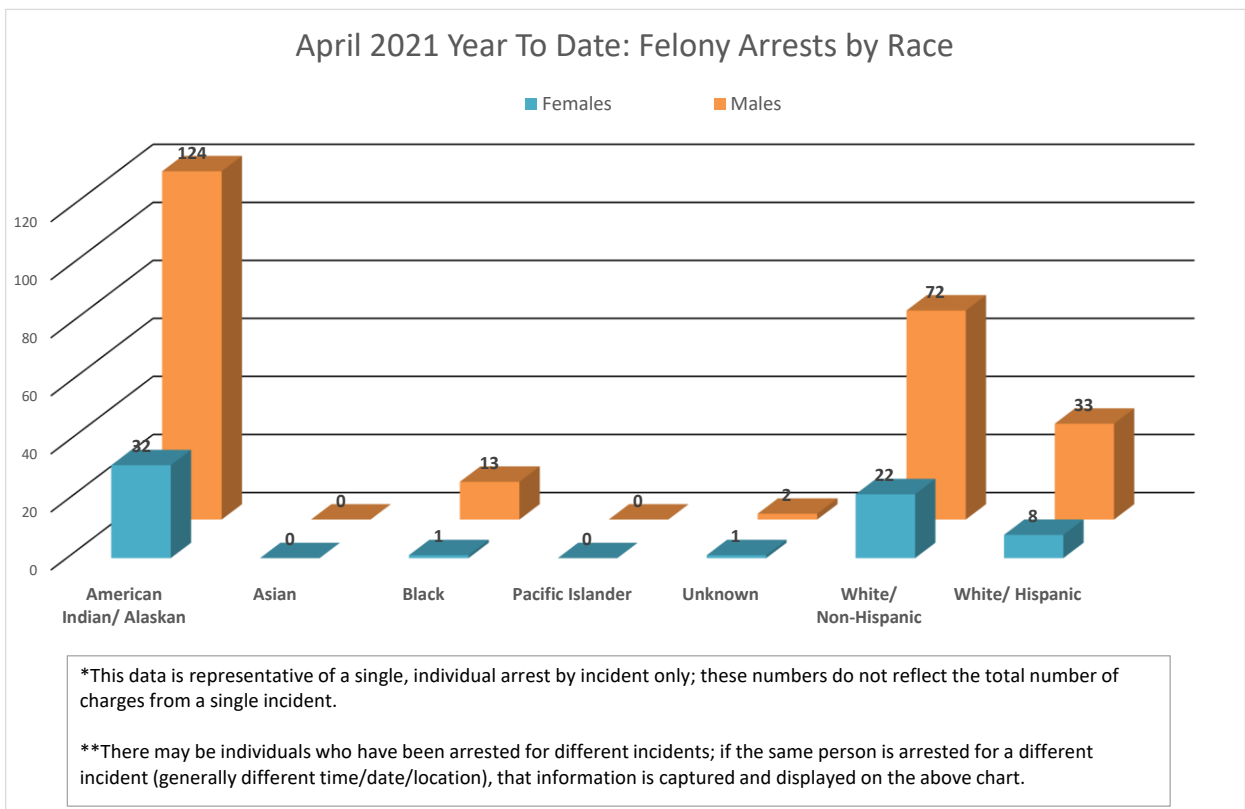
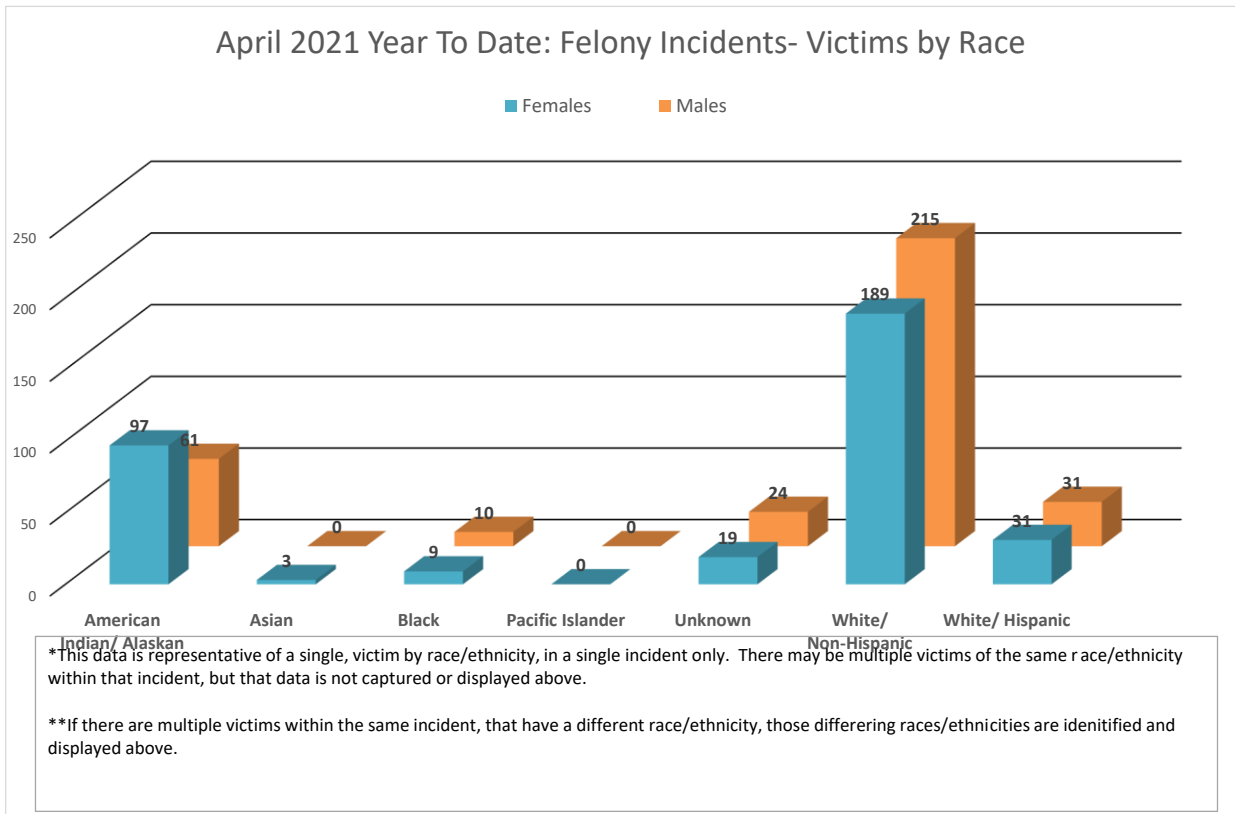
20 and 60 Minute Calls Held by Time of Day (This custom report is being configured)



20 and 60 Minute Calls Holding by Day of Week (This custom report is being configured)

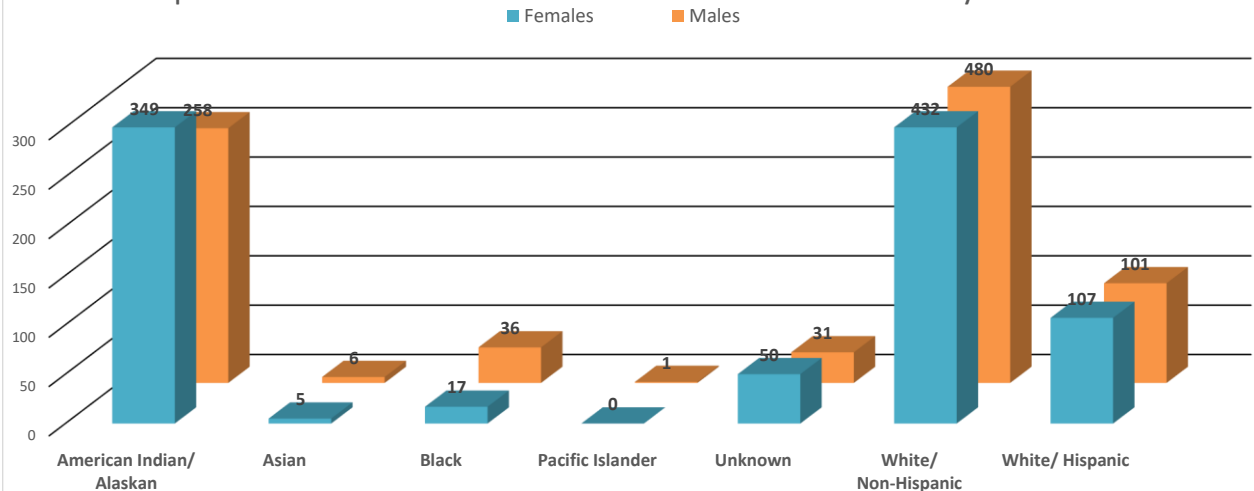

April 2021 Year To Date: Misdemeanor Incidents- Victims by Race

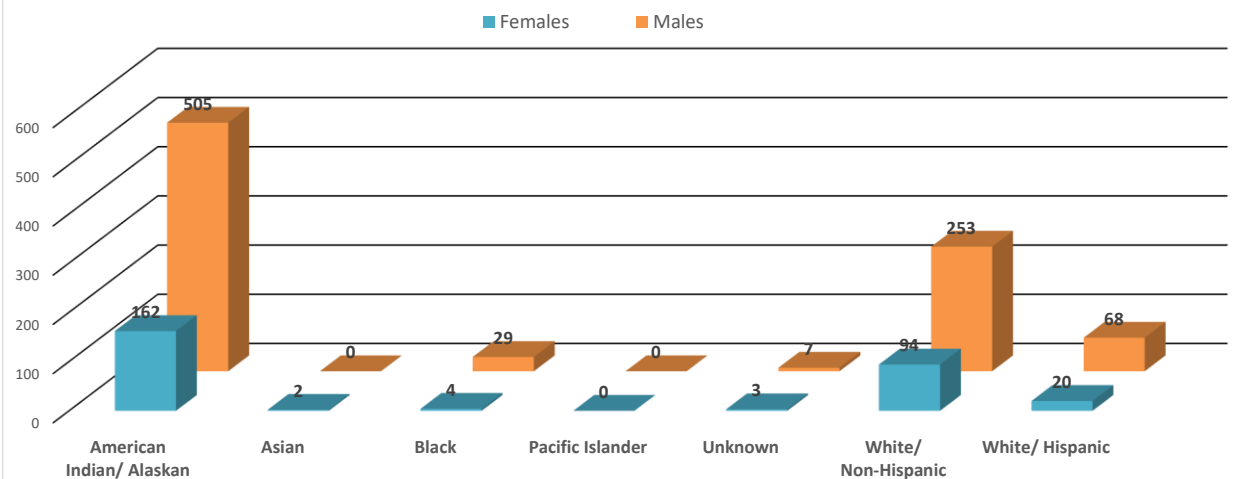
