Scavenger Waste Discharge Permit



This Permit is effective for the calendar year 2002, between the City of Flagstaff Water Services Director on behalf of the City of Flagstaff ("City"), and _____ ("Permittee"), and expires on December 31, 2022.

**** THIS IS A SINGLE VEHICLE PERMIT. A SEPARATE PERMIT IS REQUIRED FOR EACH VEHICLE THAT HAULS SCAVENGER WASTES TO THE WILDCAT HILL WRP.**

Noncompliance with any part of this permit shall subject the permit holder to revocation of permit to utilize the services of the City sewerage system for disposal of scavenger wastes. Reissuance of permit to discharge after revocation shall be at the discretion of the Director. The Permittee hereby agrees to comply with current City Code (7-02-001-0042):

- A. Acceptable Service Areas.** All service areas are subject to change at the discretion of the City. Any changes shall be in writing.
- 1. Septage Tanks:** Septic Tank service area includes waste generated from persons or companies within Coconino County.
 - 2. Grease:** Acceptable service area is within a 20 mile radius of Flagstaff city center.
 - 3. Mud sumps:** Acceptable service area is within Flagstaff city limits. All loads must be inspected and approved by the Industrial Pretreatment Program *prior* to being accepted by Wildcat Hill WRP. Please contact the Industrial Pretreatment Supervisor at (928) 213-2117 or pretreatment@flagstaffaz.gov for more information.
 - 4. All other loads:** Acceptable service area will be at the sole discretion of the City.
- B. Operating Hours.** Wildcat Hill WRP will accept scavenger wastes during normal work hours Monday thru Friday, excluding weekends and City holidays, which is defined as:
- **Summer Hours (March – October): 7:30 am to 2:45 pm**
 - **Winter Hours (November – February): 10:00 am to 2:45 pm**
 - **The City reserves the right to change hours. Please Call the Scavenger Waste hotline at (928) 213-2480 for updates to any changes in operating hours.**

- Scavenger waste may be accepted during off-hours, depending on availability and discretion of staff. All waste loads accepted during off hours will be subject to an additional \$35 fee.
- C. Single Vehicle Permit.** This is a single vehicle permit. The permittee understands that a separate permit is required for each vehicle. The permit must be carried in the vehicle at all times. A separate permit is required for each vehicle that will dispose of scavenger wastes at the WRP. Failure to provide a copy of the permit when arriving at the WRP may result in a refusal to dispose of waste at the WRP.
- D. Commodity Rate.** The rate to be paid by the Permittee for disposal of scavenger waste under this Agreement shall be the standard rate that is applicable to that class of waste in effect at the time and date, as set forth in Section 7-02-001-0041 of the Flagstaff City Code. Nothing herein shall excuse Permittee from payment of service or other charges as are applicable to the time, place, or manner of service.
- E. Compliance with Regulations.** Permittee agrees, at its sole cost and responsibility, to comply with all applicable Federal, State and local laws, regulations and standards, as now exist, and are later lawfully enacted relating to the hauling of scavenger waste.
- F. Potential Disruption of Service.** The permittee hereby agrees and accepts the possibility that the City may be required to disrupt service to the Property due to emergency conditions, safety hazards, or planned equipment maintenance. In the event of any unforeseen emergency relating to the Wildcat Hill WRP, the City may terminate acceptance of scavenger waste without prior notice to Permittee. - G. Inspection.** Permittee acknowledges and agrees that, in order to verify compliance with this Agreement and with all applicable laws and regulations, the City, State, County or other agency with jurisdiction may inspect the loads being delivered at Wildcat Hill WRP. The City may refuse to accept any discharge if it is suspected to contain wastes which are considered unacceptable to the City.
- H. Damage or Interference to WRP.** The permittee or waste hauler will be financially responsible for any damage to, or interference with the WRP, or for any expense to the City (including testing) caused by the discharge from the hauler.
- I. Sample Taps.** The permittee or waste hauler shall have sampling outlets (approved by the City) on each truck for proper sampling of contents. The permittee or waste hauler shall be subject to random sampling/monitoring by the City.
- J. Bypass Prohibition.** The permittee shall not bypass any flow control or measuring device.
- K. False Information.** Provision of false information by either the generator or the hauler shall also be considered a violation of this Code and subject to the provisions of Sections 7-02-001-0017 and 7-02-001-0019 of Flagstaff City Code.
- L. Manifests.** Each load to be discharged into the City wastewater system, shall be manifested in a form and format provided by the City of Flagstaff. The City may refuse to accept any discharge if not accompanied by a City approved manifest. Failure to provide a manifest may result in escalated enforcement, pursuant to the Water Services' Enforcement Response Plan.
- M. City's Right to Revoke.** The City shall have the right to immediately suspend or revoke this Permit, should the discharge from the Permittee present, in the opinion of the City, based upon a review of physical and chemical discharge characteristics, an imminent or substantial endangerment to the health or welfare of persons or the WRP.
- N. Fines.** In the event that the Permittee violates any portion of this Permit, or the City Code Wastewater Regulations, the Permittee shall be subject to civil penalties not to exceed twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) for each violation, according to Flagstaff City Code 7-01-001-0019.A. Each day that a specific pollutant limit exceedance occurs may constitute a separate violation.
