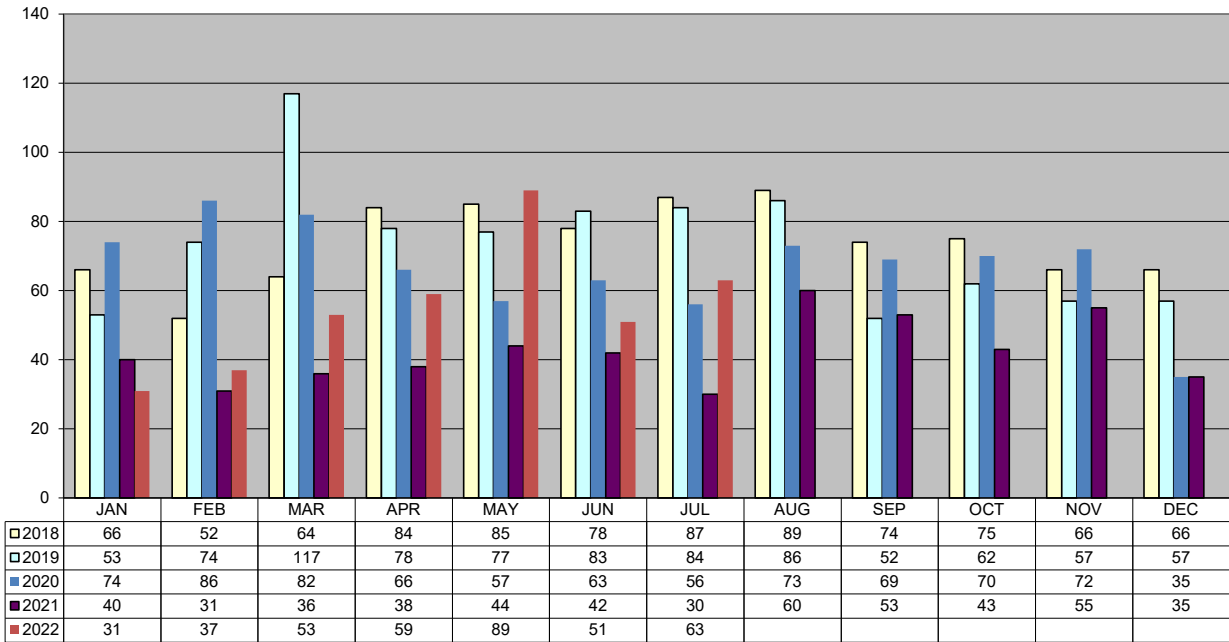

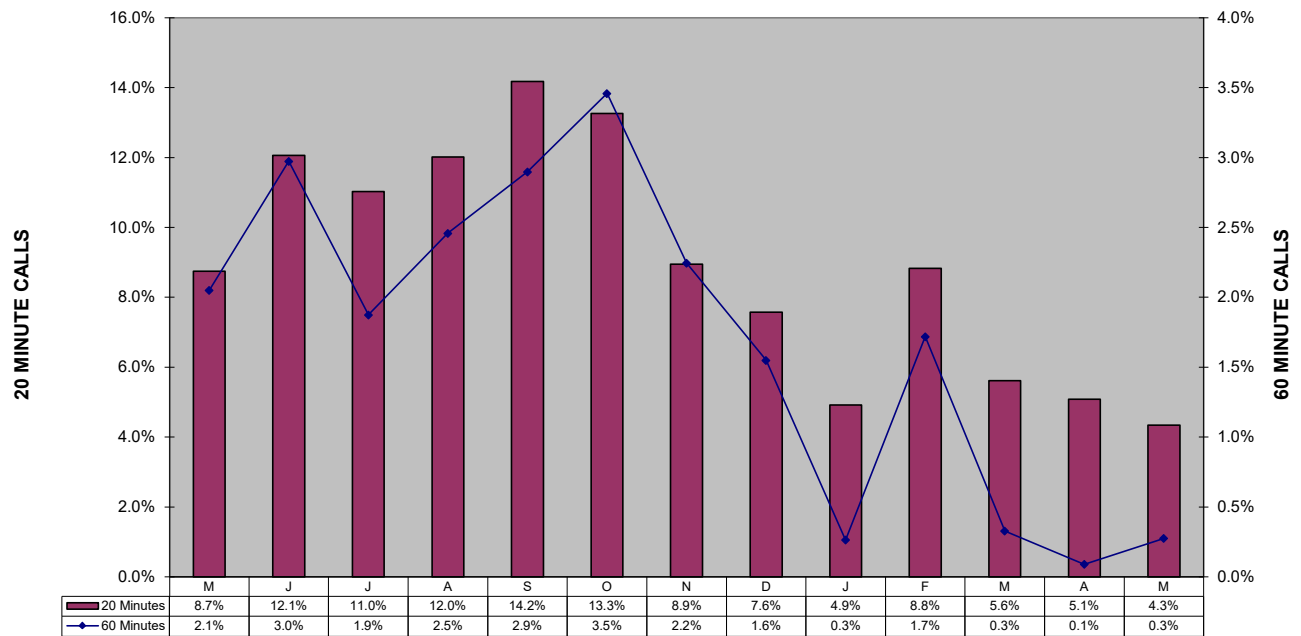
Shoplifting 5-Year Comparison



Police Calls for Service - 12 Month Trend May 2022

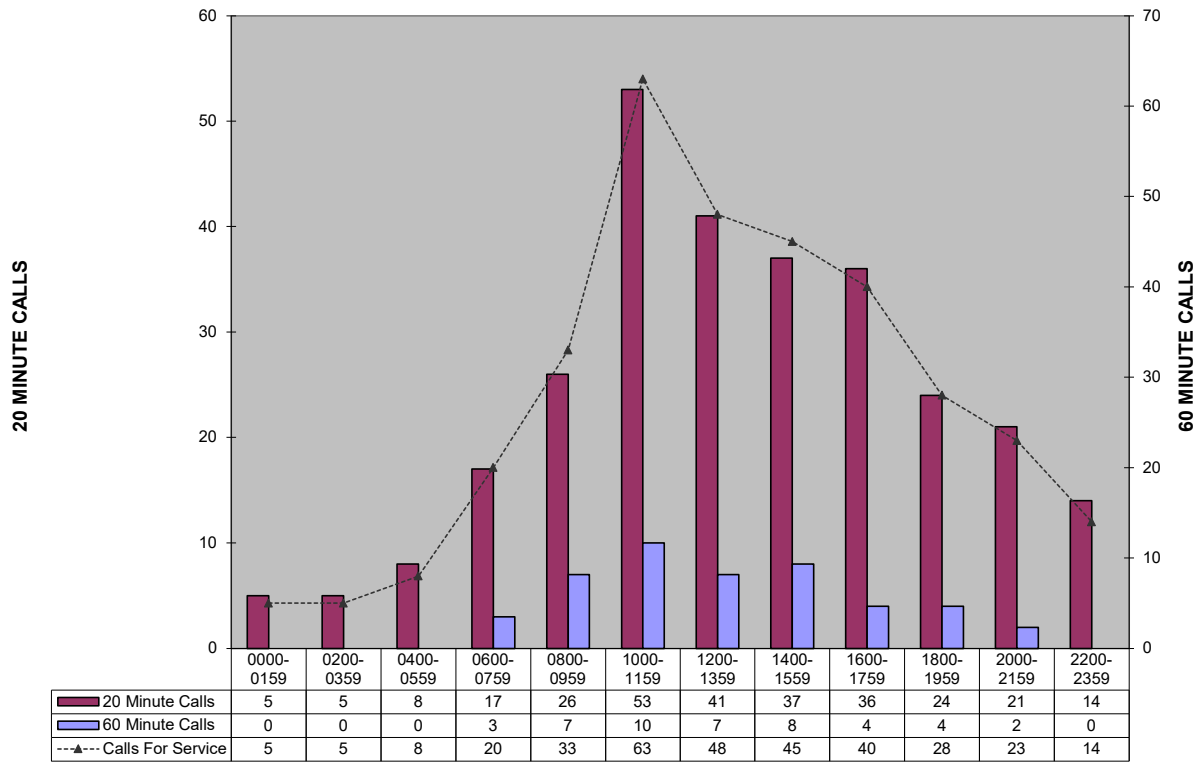


**Percent of Police Calls Held 20 and 60 Minutes
May 2021 to May 2022**

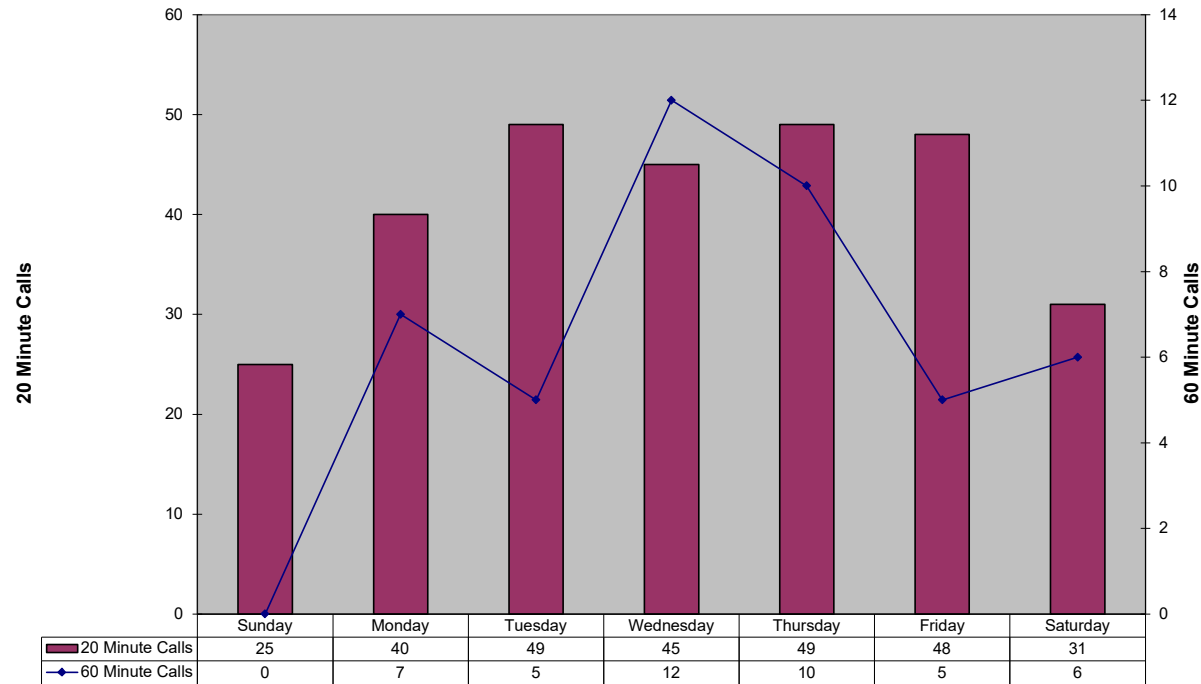

20 and 60 Minute Calls Held by Time of Day (This custom report is being configured)

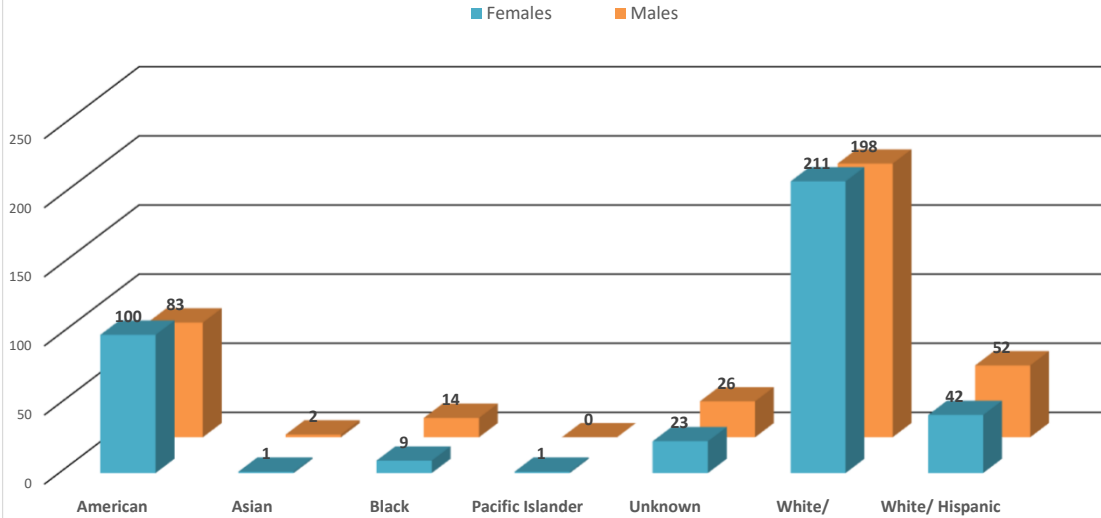


20 and 60 Minute Calls Holding by Day of Week (This custom report is being configured)

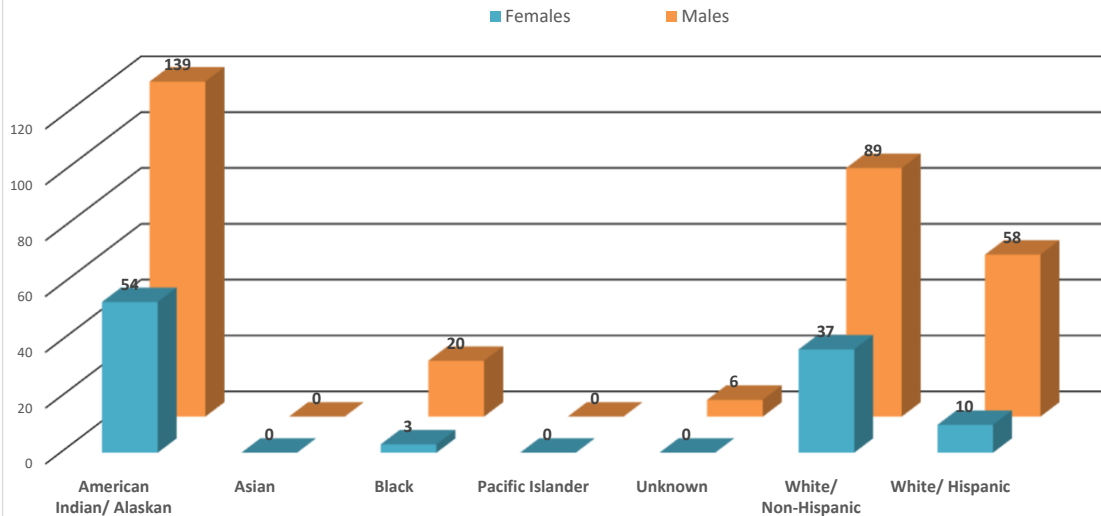

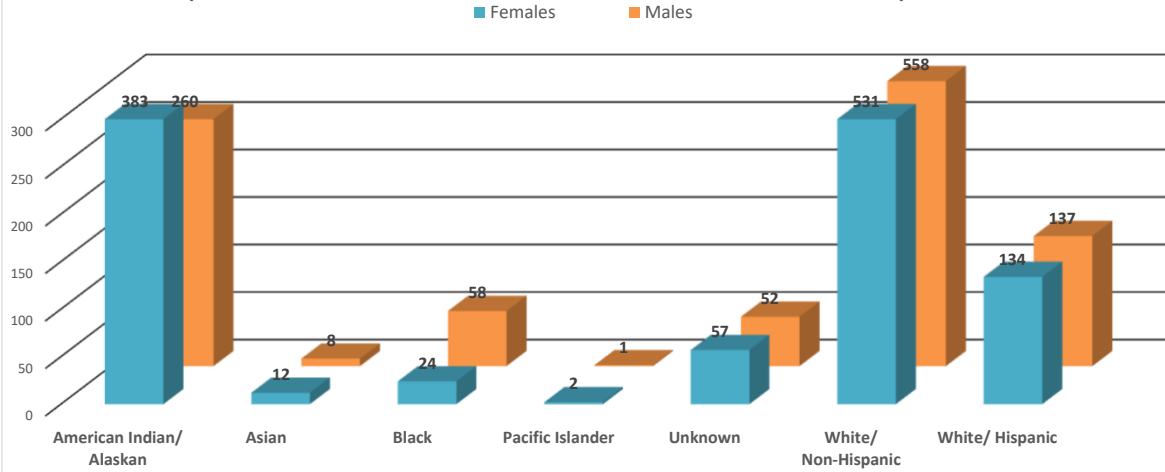

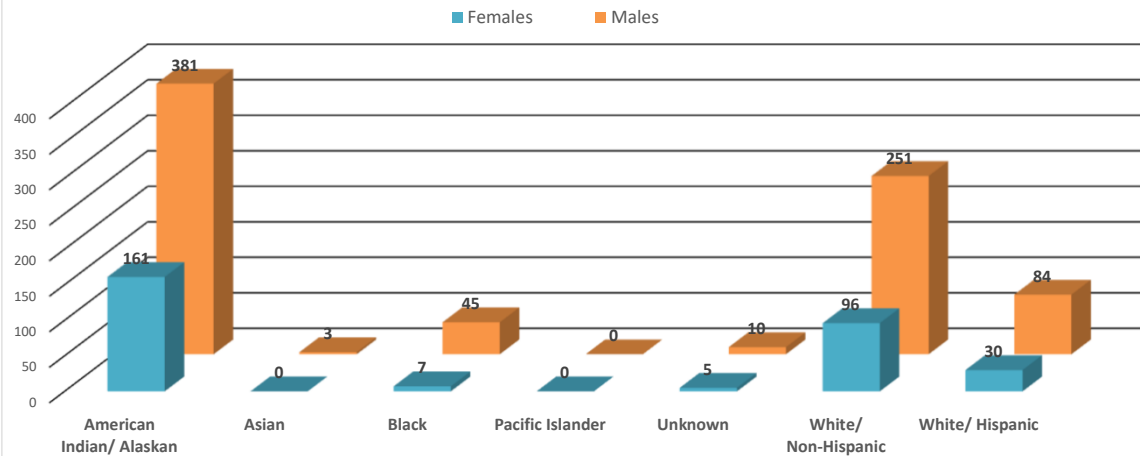
