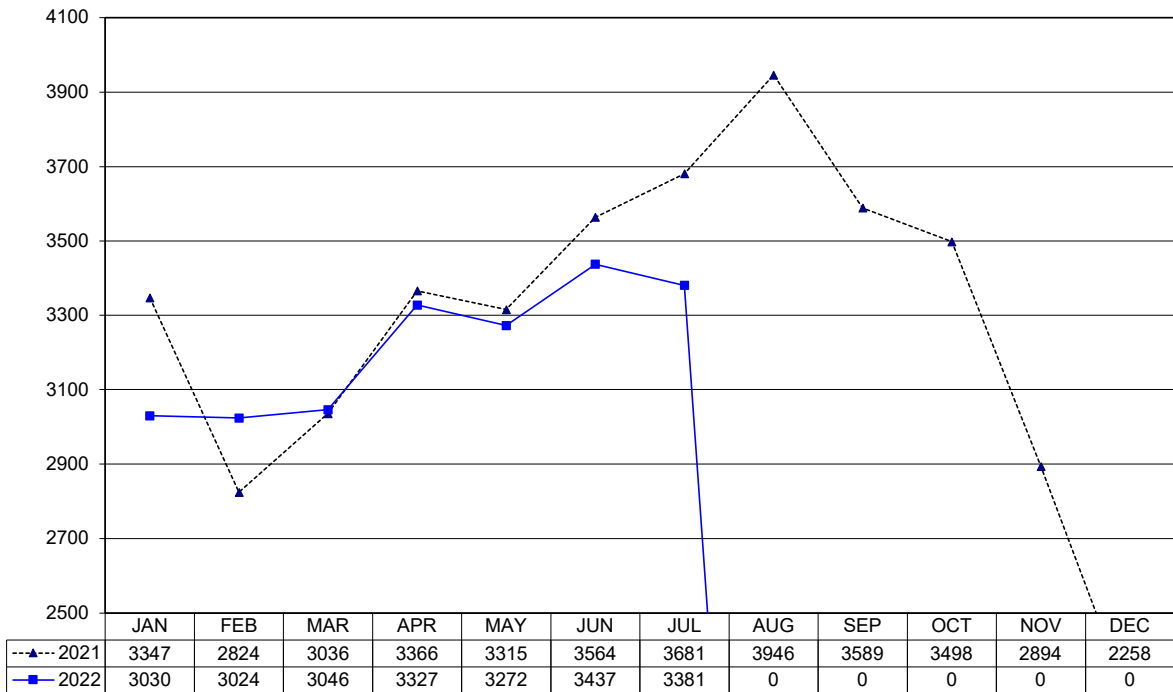

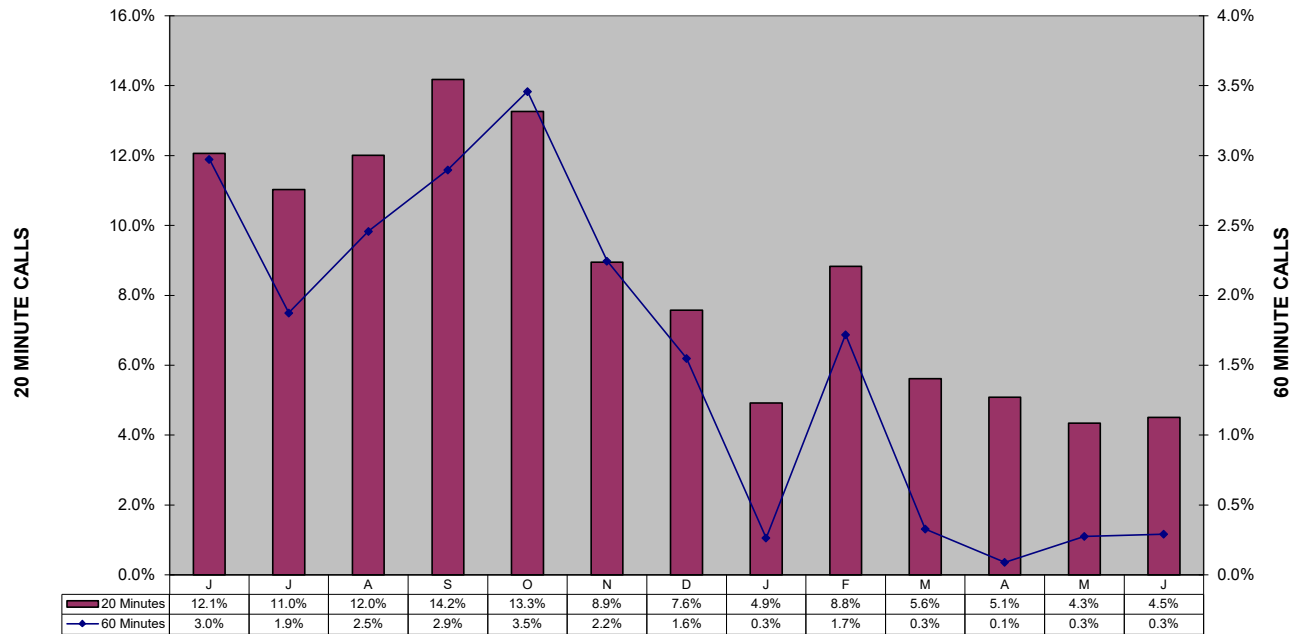
Shoplifting 5-Year Comparison



Police Calls for Service - 12 Month Trend June 2022

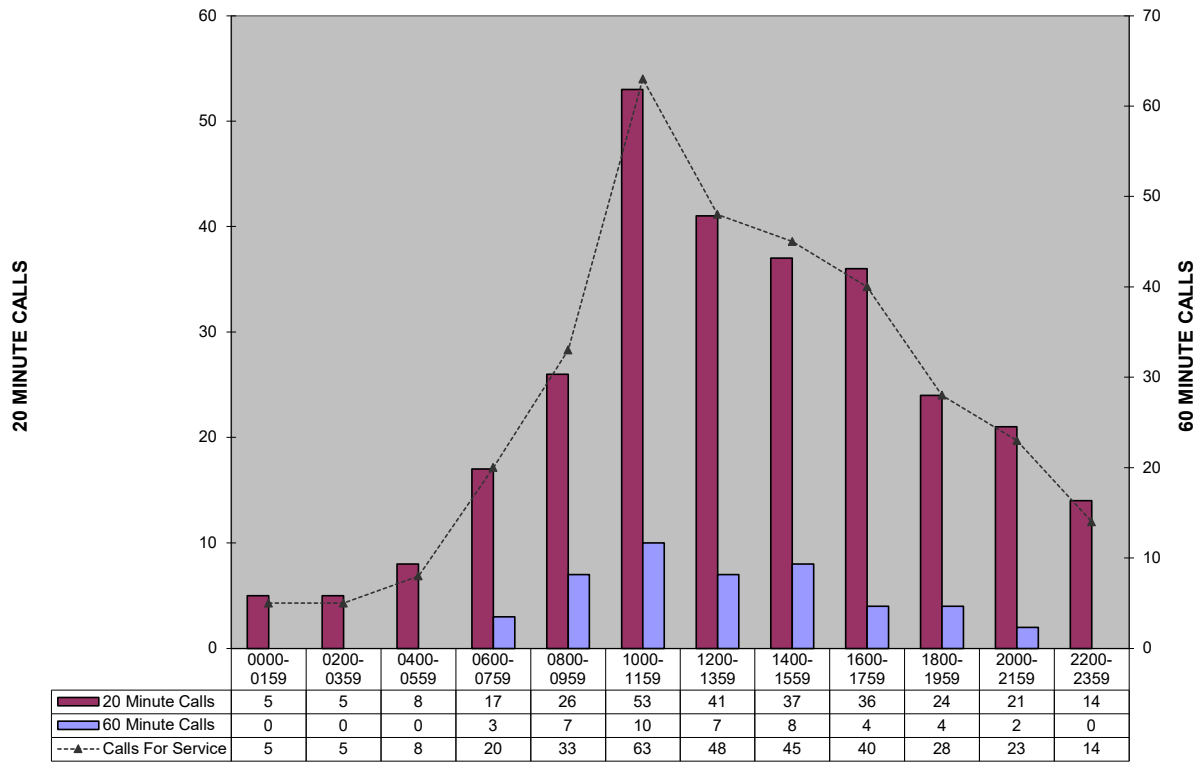


**Percent of Police Calls Held 20 and 60 Minutes
June 2021 to June 2022**

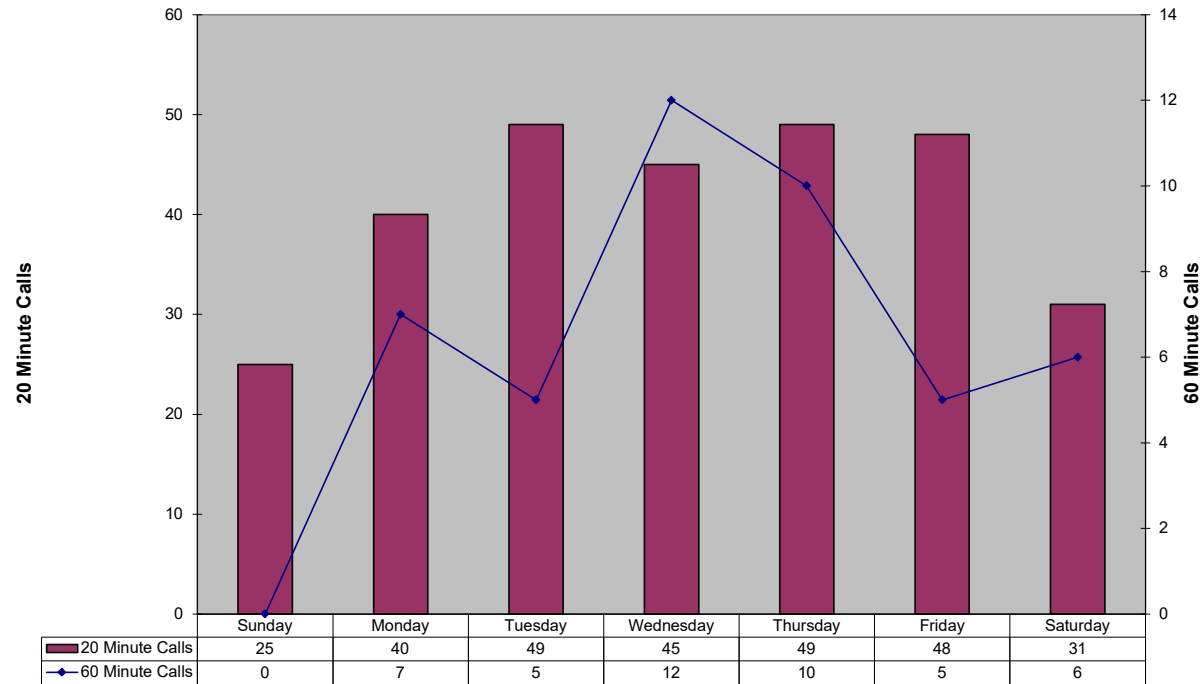

20 and 60 Minute Calls Held by Time of Day (This custom report is being configured)

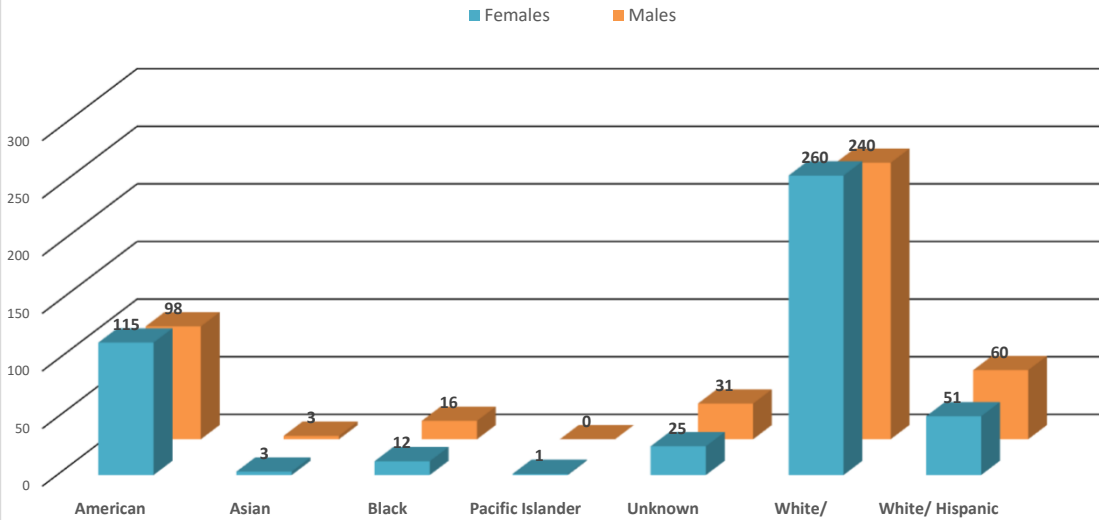


20 and 60 Minute Calls Holding by Day of Week (This custom report is being configured)

Unfortunately, we continue to see Native American members of our homeless population over-represented in both arrest and victimization data. Many of these arrests are on those who are not City residents, and many of these arrests are of repeat offenders.

June 2022 Year To Date: Felony Incidents- Victims by Race

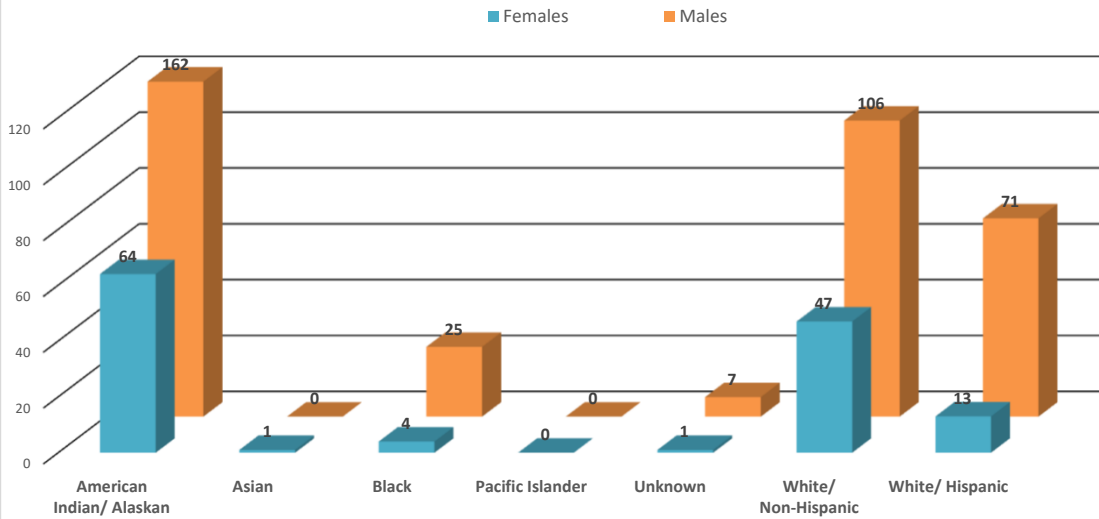

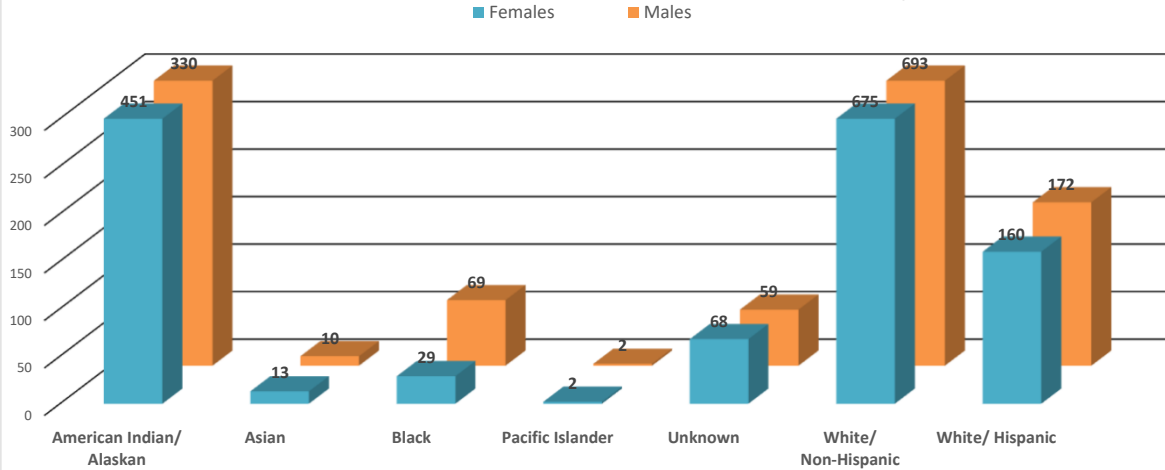

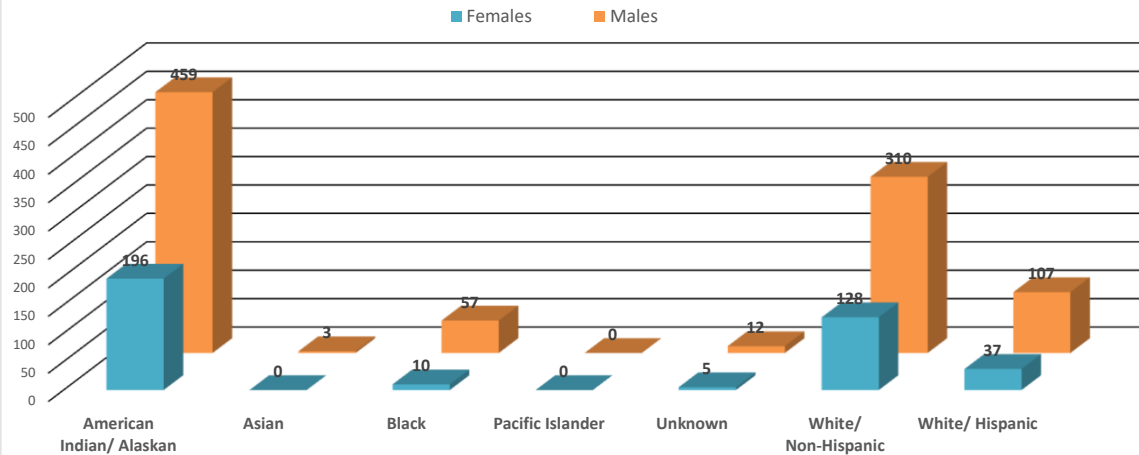
