CITY HOSTS SANBDAGGING AND WATERSHED CLEANUP VOLUNTEER DAYS

Flagstaff residents are invited to participate in volunteer days this spring and summer to help prepare neighborhoods for the upcoming monsoon season. Volunteers can assist with activities including filling sandbags, placing or removing sandbags or removing debris from channels and drainages. Watershed Clean Up series | First Saturdays June through August (9 a.m.- 12 p.m.)

- Help clean up sections of the Rio de Flag by removing trash, debris, invasive species, and trimming channel-blocking vegetation.
